Adventure Camp is an activity-based summer day camp open to children ages 4–12. We are committed to providing a safe, supportive, and engaging environment where campers can explore new interests, build friendships, and create lasting memories.

# IMPORTANT REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

- A \$20 non-refundable deposit per child, per week is required at registration.
- A 5% sibling discount is available for each additional child enrolled full-time.
- **Part-time space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- **Families must contact the Adventure Camp office to request part-time enrollment.**
- A minimum of 3 days per week is required for part-time schedules.
- All part-time schedules must be submitted at least two weeks prior to attendance.
- Part-time rates are not available for Ultimate Sports Mash-Up or Dream Big weeks.
- No credits are given for illness or single-day absences.
- No refunds or credits will be issued unless the program is cancelled by EAC.
- All cancellations must be made by the Monday prior to the first day of camp.
- If cancellation does not occur by this deadline, families will be charged the full registered weekly rate, even if the child does not attend.
- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to withdraw their child from the program if care is no longer needed.
- Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy Program is accepted with a current authorization on file.
- The Adventure Care Supervisor may approve certain fees and policies on a case-by-case basis.
- All DCE summer school participants must make bus arrangements through Lamers if they plan to be picked up and/or dropped off at summer camp.
- **All DCE summer school participants will be offered lunch at designated summer school location.**
