Timeline & Strategic Plan

Tidehaven ISD will ensure an annual decrease in uncertified teachers in foundation curriculum courses, aiming for 100% certification compliance by the 2029-2030 school year.

- Review certification requirements and timelines with individual uncertified teachers to develop a plan.
- Require principals to meet monthly with uncertified teachers to monitor certification progress.
- Partner with EPP's to support uncertified teachers.
- Prioritize the staffing of only certified teachers in kindergarten through second grade due to reading academy requirements.
- Prioritize certified applicants for all positions.
- Attend recruitment events focusing on hiring certified teachers.

The Tidehaven ISD Board of Trustees approved this plan and authorized submission of the application of delay for teacher certification requirements until the 2029-2030 school year.
