Through the McKinney-Vento program, we work to ensure students can continue learning without disruption, regardless of housing transitions. Stability at school provides consistency, routine, and a sense of belonging all of which help students thrive.



What does “Growing Toward Stability” mean?

Growing toward stability means supporting students academically, emotionally, and logistically as life circumstances change. This may include:

- Helping students remain in their school of origin
- Providing transportation assistance when eligible
- Maintaining access to meals, supplies, and academic support
- Offering consistent communication and advocacy for families
- Adjusting supports as family needs evolve

Stability does not require perfection, it starts with support.

- ✓ Students experiencing homelessness can qualify for McKinney-Vento services even if the situation is temporary
- ✓ Transportation and support services can be adjusted as circumstances change
- ✓ School stability helps reduce stress and supports academic success
- ✓ All information shared is confidential
