Sealed BIDS will be received at the Kearney Public Schools Facilities Office by the Facility Director, at 417 East 6th Street, Kearney, Nebraska on March 5th, 2026, until 2:00 PM, Local Time, and then such BIDS shall be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing all equipment, labor, materials and appurtenances required to construct 7,800 SY of 8" Thick Concrete Pavement, 10,400 SY of 6" Thick Concrete Pavement, 48,000 SF of 6" Thick Concrete Sidewalk, 1,280 LF of Storm Sewer and other such work as may be incidental to **SUNRISE MIDDLE SCHOOL PAVING IMPROVEMENTS**.
