District Goals

Richmond County Schools Goals:

Goal 1:

During the 2025-2026 school year, we will increase student content mastery in tested subject areas on the Georgia Milestones by 5%.

Goal 2:

During the 2025-2026 school year, we will increase the number of highly effective teachers and leaders retained in RCSS by 3%.

Goal 3:

During the 2025-2026 school year, we will increase post-high school readiness by increasing our graduation rate from 81% to 83%.

School Goals

Bayvale Elementary Goals:

- I. By the end of the 2025- 2026 school year, BES will increase the content mastery score by 20% in grades 3-5 from 27.66% to 47.66% in ELA as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment.
- II. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, BES will increase the content mastery score by 5% in grades 3-5 in Math as measured by the Georgia Milestones Assessment.
- III. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, BES will continue to build a supportive learning environment that integrates social, emotional, and academic support and instruction to increase student attendance by 10%, decrease student suspension by 20%, and decrease by 20% student/staff negative responses on SHS (question #6: Teachers treat mw with respect.) and SAI survey (question #28: Building capacity through professional learning & question #46 which is relevant to coaching cycles.)

Bayvale Elementary Focus Area: Reading and Math

Our school will strive to meet the goals in reading and math through consistent and rigorous instruction.

School Responsibilities:

Bayvale Elementary will:

- Provide families with a leveled book and reading response activity to work with students at home
- Provide addition and subtraction strategies for families to work with students at home
- Provide families with math methods resources and examples through web access to assist completion of student's math homework.
- Provide families with information about school

Student Responsibilities:

- Listen and follow directions routinely.
- Discuss with my parents what I'm learning in school.
- Share information and signed papers with teachers.
- Ask for help when I do not understand.
- Read at home daily.
- Bring materials to school.
- Obey the students' rules and take pride in my school and community.

At Home

- Attend school wide events to learn academic strategies to utilize at home.
