



SUMMER CAMP NON-STUDENT RELEASE/WAIVER

This information is required before a student who is not an enrolled student at The Alexander Dawson School at Rainbow Mountain (the “School”) attends its “Summer Camp” as a “Participant.” In order for your student to attend the Summer Camp, you must submit this form no later than one week before your student’s first day of the Summer Camp. I hereby certify that the Participant is in good physical and mental condition and has no previous or pre-existing medical conditions or injuries affecting his/her ability to participate in the Summer Camp, nor has he/she been declared medically ineligible for any athletic competition.

PARTICIPANT HEALTH INSURANCE: I understand that the School requires the Participant to have health insurance coverage to participate in the Summer Camp. I understand that the School is not responsible for medical costs, and I agree to reimburse the School for any medical expenses that the School incurs on behalf of the Participant.

CONSENT TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND TREATMENT: If I cannot be reached, the emergency contacts listed above will be called. I authorize the School to call an ambulance to transport the Participant to a hospital or medical facility and to secure the necessary medical treatment for the Participant. Staff is trained in the basics of first aid and CPR, and I authorize them to give the Participant first aid. Any staff member responsible for the participant's care and education may view the Participant’s health information. I agree to alert the School to any allergies my student has, such as to bee stings, medications, or foods.

OVER-THE-COUNTER AND/OR PRESCRIBED MEDICATION: I understand that over-the-counter and/or prescribed medication cannot be administered to the Participant by a School staff member while attending the Summer Camp unless accompanied by a current physician’s prescription.

CHILD INJURIES: If my child sustains a minor injury (e.g., scraped knee) during care, I understand that I will receive a verbal update when I arrive to pick up my child. The school staff will contact me immediately if the injury produces any type of swelling or needs medical attention.

ILLNESS: In case of illness, the Participant is not permitted to attend the Summer Camp. The Participant must be picked up as soon as possible to ensure the Participant’s comfort and reduce the contagion risk. Until then, the Participant will be kept comfortable and will continue to be observed for symptoms. I understand that if the Participant is symptomatic (fever at/over 100 degrees, undiagnosed rash, cough, sore throat, headache, excessive fatigue, vomiting, trouble breathing, or diarrhea), they must remain home until symptom-free for 24 hours without medication.

PERMISSION TO RELEASE INFORMATION: I understand that while the Participant is attending the Summer Camp, an administrator may be asked for basic information regarding the Participant. I understand that Southern Nevada Health District and/or other agencies may be granted access to the Participant's record upon request to ensure compliance with state, county, and local regulations.

PARTICIPANT MEDIA RELEASE: I authorize the School, its successors and assigns, and those acting with its permission and upon its authority to use the Participant's name, photographic image, audio, and video recordings, and reproductions of the Participant's art or other work (whether in electronic or other formats) (collectively referred to as "Participant Media") in the School's publications, marketing, and promotional materials, website, social media outlets, press releases, and/or advertising media. I waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product in any format wherein the Participant Media appears. I acknowledge the School's right to crop or alter any photographic image of the Participant at its discretion. I authorize the School to use or reproduce the Participant Media on more than one occasion, without limitation, in perpetuity, and without compensation. I hereby release the School, its successors and assigns, and those acting with its permission and under its authority from any liability, responsibility, or claim that may arise by reason of any exercise of its authority, as indicated in this provision. I acknowledge and understand that this provision survives the termination of this agreement. A media release exemption form can be obtained by contacting the business office.

LIABILITY RELEASE & INDEMNIFICATION. I fully realize the risks associated with the Participant's participation in the Summer Camp. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks on my behalf and the Participant's behalf. I understand there are risks associated with participation in the Summer Camp programs. I understand these risks include, by way of example and not limitation, the dangers, and risks involved in activities in the classroom, during snack and lunch periods, on the playground, during physical education classes, during water activities, including swimming, and during vehicular travel, all with the possibility of property loss or damage, physical injury, pain, mental trauma, or death. I represent and warrant that I have enrolled the Participant in any and all insurance, including, but not limited to, health care, accident, travel, and personal property insurance that I believe, in my sole judgment, is necessary to protect the Participant while attending the Summer Camp.

In consideration of the voluntary enrollment of the Participant in the Summer Camp and participation in any and all of the activities associated with the program (including events and activities on and off campus), and with an understanding of the risks described above, I agree, on my own behalf and that of the Participant, to forever release, acquit, discharge, and covenant not to sue the School, its officers, trustees, employees, volunteers, donors, representatives, and agents, ("Releasees") from any and all claims, suits, liabilities, actions and causes of action, including, but not limited to, claims of negligence on the part of Releasees, which I or the Participant or our heirs, legal representatives, successors, conservators and assigns may have, now or in the future, which arise directly or indirectly out of the Participant's attendance of the Summer Camp.

I hereby agree, on my own behalf and on behalf of the Participant, to indemnify Releasees from and against any and all claims, suits, actions, causes of action including, but not limited to, claims of negligence, and any other liabilities, including attorneys' fees by any person arising out of, or resulting directly or indirectly from the Participant's attendance at the Summer Camp, including, but not limited to, damage to personal property caused by the Participant or injury of any person caused by the Participant.

This Liability Release and Indemnity Agreement covers any property or personal loss or damage or other loss caused or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by the ordinary negligence (but not gross negligence) of Releasees.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT/NO WAIVER: This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties with regard to the matters herein and supersedes any other agreement or understandings, whether written or oral and cannot be changed unless agreed upon and signed by an authorized representative of the School in writing. Any waiver of any

obligation of either party to the Agreement by the other party shall not be construed to be a waiver of any other obligations or the same obligation on a future occasion.

SEVERABILITY & COUNTERPARTS: The terms of this Agreement are independent of each other. If a term in the Agreement is deemed unenforceable by a court, the remaining terms shall remain in full force and effect. Multiple copies of this Agreement may be signed, all of which constitute one and the same agreement.

JURISDICTION: I acknowledge and agree that this Agreement is entered into in the State of Nevada, that its validity, effect, and operation shall be determined according to the laws of Nevada (but not its conflict of laws rules), and I agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in Nevada.

ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE: By signing below, I acknowledge and agree that I have carefully read this Agreement, fully understand that this Agreement is a binding and enforceable legal obligation, and agree to its provisions. I am signing this Agreement as the parent, legal guardian, Participant, and/or the individual responsible for the Participant's attendance at the Summer Camp.

By signing below, I acknowledge and agree that my electronic signature has the same legal effect and validity as my written signature and that this Agreement is valid and will be given the same legal effect as a written and signed agreement. I further acknowledge and agree that no certification authority or other third-party verification is necessary to validate my electronic signature and that the lack of such certification or third-party verification will not in any way affect the enforceability of my electronic signature of this binding agreement between the School and me. My consent to the electronic signature below applies only to this Agreement and does not apply to any separate transactions or communications with the School. I may request a paper copy of my completed and binding Agreement by printing the completed Agreement from the online portal.
