Dress-Up Day Guidelines

Each concert day at East Elementary, we give the entire student body a chance to participate, whether as a performer or an audience member, in the beauty of the day by offering a whole school dress-up day. Our guidelines for these days are that students may choose to dress up, dressier than the normal uniform, or they can always choose to wear their uniform. Denim is not included in dress up days. Here are some additional guidelines for choosing dress-up outfits.

- Dresses or shorts need to follow the handbook guidelines, no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- No spaghetti strap tops, tops may be sleeveless, but fabric must come to the edge of the shoulder
- No makeup
- Shoes heels should be 1 inch or shorter
- Large dangling or large hoop-style earrings are not allowed for safety reasons

Curriculum

Spelling—Our weekly spelling test (Friday, 2/20) will cover List 18 and Rule 3.

[RULE 3: The letter g before e, i, or y may say j (giant), but followed by any other letter says g (gate).]

Math – In chapter eleven, we continue to calculate area and perimeter. This week we will expand our knowledge to include calculating the area of composite figures.

Writing –We will complete the model entitled “The Toothbrush” using inventive writing.

Reading – We are continuing in *Pollyanna* (literature) and *Little Britches* (read-aloud).

Grammar – In Week 22 of Fix-It Grammar, we will review coordinating conjunctions and vocabulary words including abundant, sociable, and survey.

Poetry- February’s recitation will be an excerpt from Patrick Henry’s 1775 Speech. This will be a formal recitation **due on Thursday, 2/26**.

History –We have begun our new unit on the American Revolution.

Science –As we wrap up our unit on human respiration and circulation, students will take a test on key concepts. They will be allowed to reference their science journals for this assessment.
