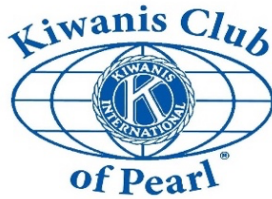

- Demonstrated educational aptitude as reflected in standardized test scores.

Two (2) copies of the completed and signed application, essay, letters of reference, and official transcript (including grades and test scores) must be received **no later than Thursday, April 2, 2026 by 3:00 p.m.**

Late applications will **not** be accepted.
