BELLAIRE HIGH SCHOOL CHEERLEADER APPLICATION 2026-2027
{Varsity AND Junior Varsity}

In order to try out for the position of Junior Varsity or Varsity cheerleader for the 2026-2027 school year, applicants must meet the following qualifications. Please be sure to check the qualifications carefully before applying. Please note, Junior Varsity consists of only underclassmen {Freshman & Sophomores} and Varsity consists of only upperclassmen {Juniors & Seniors}. So, if you are currently an 8th or 9th grader, you are trying out for JV, and if you are currently a 10th or 11th grader, you are trying out for Varsity.

- ____ 1. Applicants must be passing all classes currently and in all preceding six-weeks of the current school year. No failing six-week grade or semester average (that is, "69" or below) on your report card will be accepted. This is because cheerleaders are active during all UIL sports seasons {Volleyball, Football, Basketball, Soccer, Softball and Baseball} and the entire squad relies on each member to be in good standing and able to participate at all times throughout the school year. If you don't prioritize your classes, you are not able to prioritize cheerleading. Those selected as a Varsity or JV cheerleader must maintain a passing average with no failing grades for the remainder of the school year, or they will be put on probation and will not be permitted to try out for the following school year.
- ____ 2. Applicants must have no lower than an "S" conduct average currently and in all of the preceding six weeks of the current school year. No "P 's" or "U's" in any class are acceptable. Additionally, if an applicant has been suspended or expelled for any reason, they will not be permitted to try out.
- ____ 3. Applicants will agree to represent the school in a manner consistent with the Bellaire High School and HISD Code of Student Conduct. This applies at all times, whether in or out of cheerleading uniform.
- ____ 4. Applicants will agree to make BHS cheerleading responsibilities a priority. Being a cheerleader is a privilege and an honor, and hard work and responsible conduct are required. Cheerleaders must attend all required events, except in the case of personal illness, death in the family, or approved school business.
- ____ 5. Applicants should be financially able to buy uniforms, pay for summer camp, and pay any expenses which might become necessary in the course of the school year's events. Approximately \$2000 will be required to be paid for all uniforms/attire by the end of school, May 2026.
- ____ 6. Applicants must attend all practice sessions before tryouts, and those selected must attend any and all practice sessions before cheerleading camp or they will be put on a probationary status with the squad. **Applicants also must be able to attend the 4-day cheerleading camp in June,** and Varsity team members Cardinal Camp in August.

- ___ 7. **Cheerleading is a year-long activity.** You must commit and follow through with your decision to try out for this squad. No cheerleader may quit prior to the end of the school year unless suspended from the squad for grades or misconduct. Failure to comply will result in a semester grade of a "50" in the course or if the cheerleader quits for the entire second semester, a semester average of "0" will be given.

- ___ 8. Applicants and their parents will understand that making the JV or Varsity squad this year does not automatically guarantee that they will make either squad the following year. Everyone who has the grades will have to try out again the next year to remain on the squad.

- ___ 9. **All 8th grade applicants must be certain in the decision to attend Bellaire High School in order to tryout.**

I have read the above requirements, and I agree that I will abide by the rules stated, that my grades and conduct meet the above requirements, and I understand that I am subject to suspension from the cheerleading team if I do not abide by these rules and regulations.
