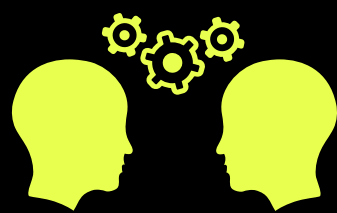

## JANUARY INDUCTION COACH WORKSHOPS

The second semester of Induction begins THIS WEEK. Please begin your Collaborative Logs and retake your CSTP Self-Assessment (complete the middle set of columns). This will be used to identify 2-3 new CSTPs to focus on this semester and to revise your ILP. Please continue using your current ILP Form, under the on the “second semester” portion of your current ILP. You will need to identify your SMARTIE Goal by February 15 to stay on track ([see Pacing Guide](#)).

## EARLY COMPLETION OPTION

If you submitted an Early Completion option Application in December, we will be sending out letters informing you of your status next week.

For those of you who are new to Induction, applications for second semester are due April 1. Experienced and exceptional teachers with at least 3 years as a teacher of record may apply to complete the Induction Program in one year. ## ADVISORY BOARD

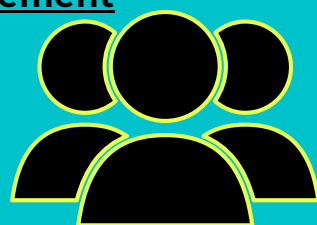
