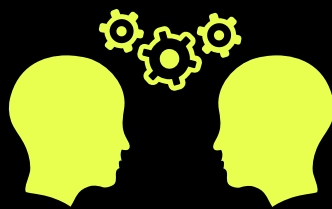

MARCH INDUCTION COACH WORKSHOPS



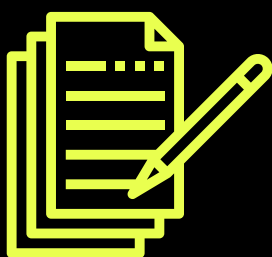

FEBRUARY INDUCTION WORK

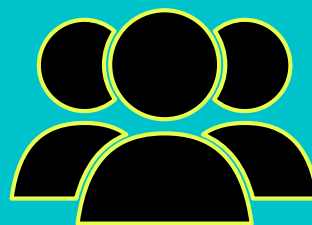
