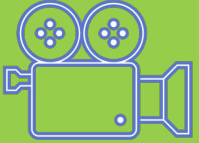

3. SELECT THE "REQUESTS"
4. CLICK "ADD/EDIT REQUESTS"
5. NOT ALL COURSES WILL HAVE A DESCRIPTION, REFER TO THE [ASD PROGRAM OF STUDIES](#) FOR MORE INFO.
6. **FIRST** - ADD YOUR 4 CORE CLASSES (ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES).
SECOND - ADD UP TO 6 ELECTIVE CLASSES.

7. IF YOU HAVE MORE THAN THREE ELECTIVE REQUESTS, YOU WILL NEED TO DESIGNATE ADDITIONAL REQUESTS AS ALTERNATES. USE THE DROPDOWN MENU NEXT TO EACH COURSE YOU WISH TO MARK AS ALTERNATE.
