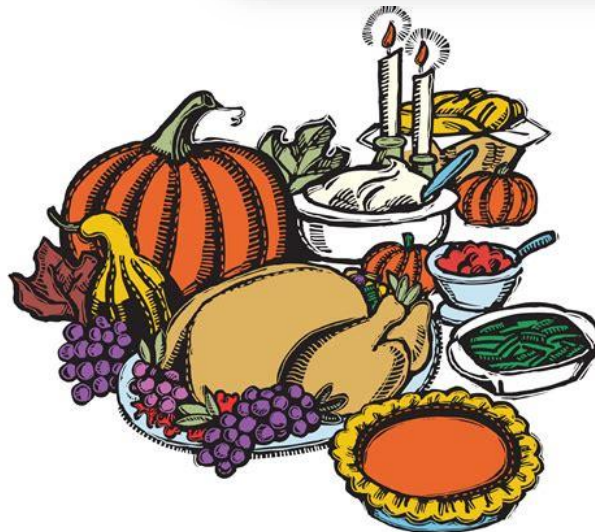


## Wissahickon

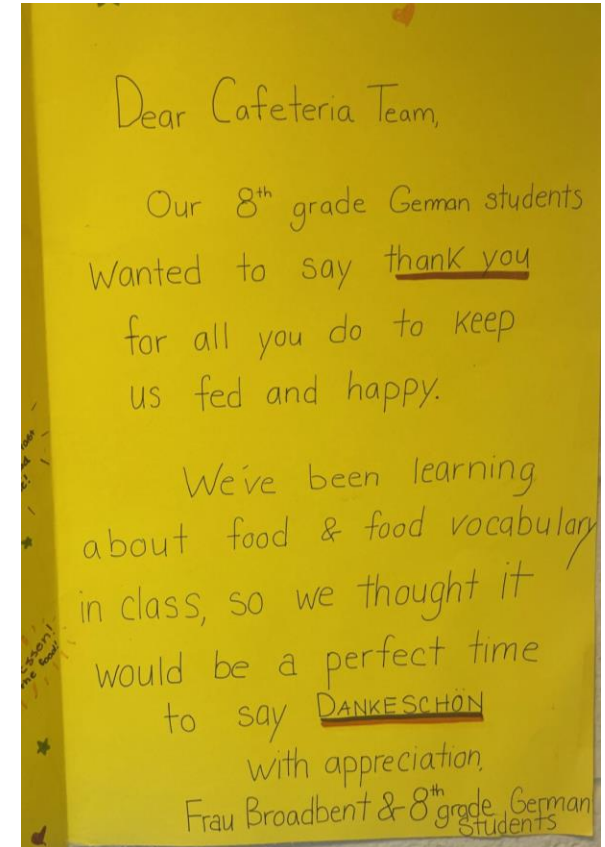

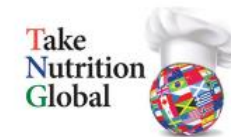
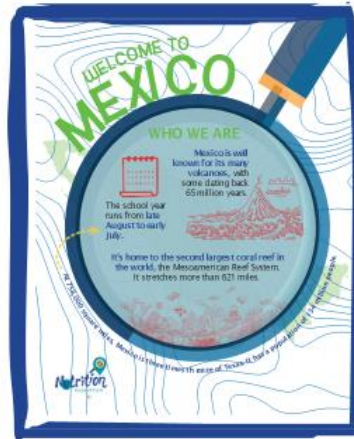


# Taking students on delicious adventures around the world!
