Our motto is:

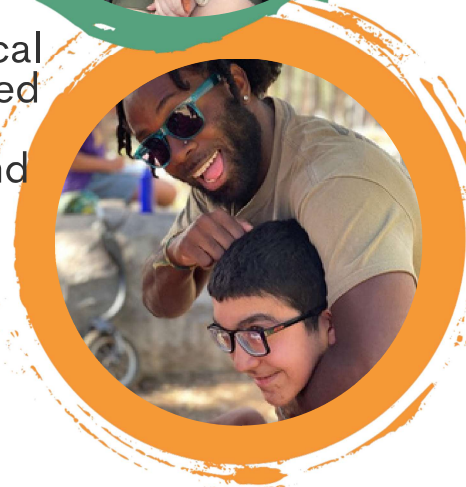
