**PLAYOFF/CITY CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES**

- Top four teams from each section make it to playoffs – a total of 8 boys' teams and 8 girls' teams

**Tie Breaker-**

**When Two Teams Are Tied:**

- A. Head-to-head result between the two teams.
- B. Common opponent results, based on order of finish.
- C. Coin flip between the two teams.

**When Three or More Teams Are Tied:**

- A. Form a *mini-conference* with the tied teams and break the tie using the best head-to-head record within that group.
- B. If still tied, use point differential within the mini-conference, with a maximum of 15 points per game counted.
- C. If still tied, a coin flip between the 3 tied teams. **Odd coin wins. If it is a 4 (or more) way tie, names will be drawn out of a hat.**
