Certificate Courses

Course Structure

- **Module 2:** Risk Management: Identifying and Assessing Risks in Boarding Houses. Describe the key elements of a risk management framework along with methods for identifying risks in a Boarding House and performing a risk assessment.
- **Module 3:** Risk Mitigation and Risk Artefacts. Explain how risks can be reduced through the application of key controls and the importance of key risk artefacts that should be prepared and maintained for a Boarding House.
- **Module 4:** Case Study. Participants will work through a case study to demonstrate a deep understanding of risk management within a Boarding House setting.
