

Granville High School CCP Course Information Sheet

Granville High School's College Credit Plus is Ohio's program for creating advanced standing opportunities for high school students. Through CCP, high schools partner with public universities to create "pathways" of college classes in which they would receive university and high school credit. Granville High School currently partners with Ashland University, Central Ohio Technical College and Shawnee State University to provide on-site courses.

1. If you intend to do College Credit Plus, the first step is to complete the Intent form:
2. Indicate on your schedule that you wish to enroll in the specific CCP course.

Ashland University

In partnership with Ashland University, GHS offers courses in US Government. Courses in these pathways are taught by GHS instructors on site at GHS. The accompanying course descriptions can be found in the current GHS course catalog.

To apply for Ashland University CCP Courses, students must:

1. Complete the student application here: <http://ashland.edu/apply>
 - a. Use a personal email (such as Gmail) to apply, NOT a high school or parent email address.
 - b. Complete and upload the permission slip to your application. The link is available within the application and at ashland.edu/ccp-permission-slip
 - c. If you are a HS sophomore or older, you will be admitted with an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher. If your GPA is 2.50-2.99 or if you have not yet finished the 9th grade, you must take the Accuplacer Reading section. Contact the high school guidance office for instructions.
2. Activate your AU account and check your AU email regularly for updates.
3. Notify the high school guidance office to register for AU's political science course at the high school.
4. Complete the new student orientation here: <http://ashland.edu/ccp-orientation> by the deadline outlined in your acceptance email.

COTC

In partnership with the Career and Technical Education Center (C-TEC) of Licking County, GHS offers courses in Business, Information Technologies and Visual Arts. Courses in these pathways are taught by GHS and C-TEC instructors on site at GHS. The accompanying course descriptions can be found in the Fine Arts, Business and Technology sections of this catalogue.

To apply for COTC CCP Courses, students will need to complete the following:

1. Review the CCP Student Guide

2. Student application using this link: <https://www.cotc.edu/apply-0>
3. Sign (student and parent) and return the Mature Content Permission Slip to COTC.

4. Set up your COTC Student account. You will receive an email and a letter within one week that contains your temporary password and instructions to retrieve your username for logging in to myCOTC, your student portal. This is where you can access your student email account, online courses, grades and more.
5. Activate your COTC email/account as soon as you receive your instructions. Your COTC email is the official means of communication between you and COTC.
6. Complete COTC orientation. You will be notified via your personal email address once you have enrolled in online orientation.
7. Sign and return course registration card to your counselor
8. Register for the Fall 2026 or Spring 2027 term.
9. Students will need to meet the COTC Course Requirements. It may be necessary to complete a Placement exam.

Ohio State University – Newark

To apply for Shawnee State University CCP Courses, students will need to complete the following:

1. Submit the SSU CCP Student application.
 - a. First-time CCP students will apply here: <https://admissions.shawnee.edu/register/CCP>
 - b. Current SSU CCP students will reapply here: https://admissions.shawnee.edu/register/CCP_Return
2. Submit school transcripts, test scores (Accuplacer, ACT, or SAT), and mature content forms to SSU
3. Please note, students without a current high school GPA (typically students in grades 7-9) can only be admitted to SSU's CCP program based on their placement test scores. We will not admit students based on a junior high GPA.
4. Students will need to meet the SSU Course Requirements.
