

Granville High School CCP Options and Eligibility Guide

The deadline to apply is March 27, 2026.

Step 1: Check Your GPA

Do you have an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher?

✓ Yes: You're eligible for CCP courses that require a 3.0+ GPA.

✗ No: Go to Step 2: Placement Scores.

Do you have an unweighted GPA of 2.5 or higher?

✓ Yes: You may qualify, but you'll need placement test scores (ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer).

✗ No: You must rely on placement test scores for eligibility.

Step 2: Check Your Placement Scores

You may qualify if you meet any of the following:

ACT: 18 ACT Composite or English 18, Reading 22 or Math 22

SAT: 970 SAT or Reading/Writing 480 or Math 530

Accuplacer: 250 Reading, 263 Writing or 263 QAS

✓ If you meet these scores, you're eligible for most CCP courses.
