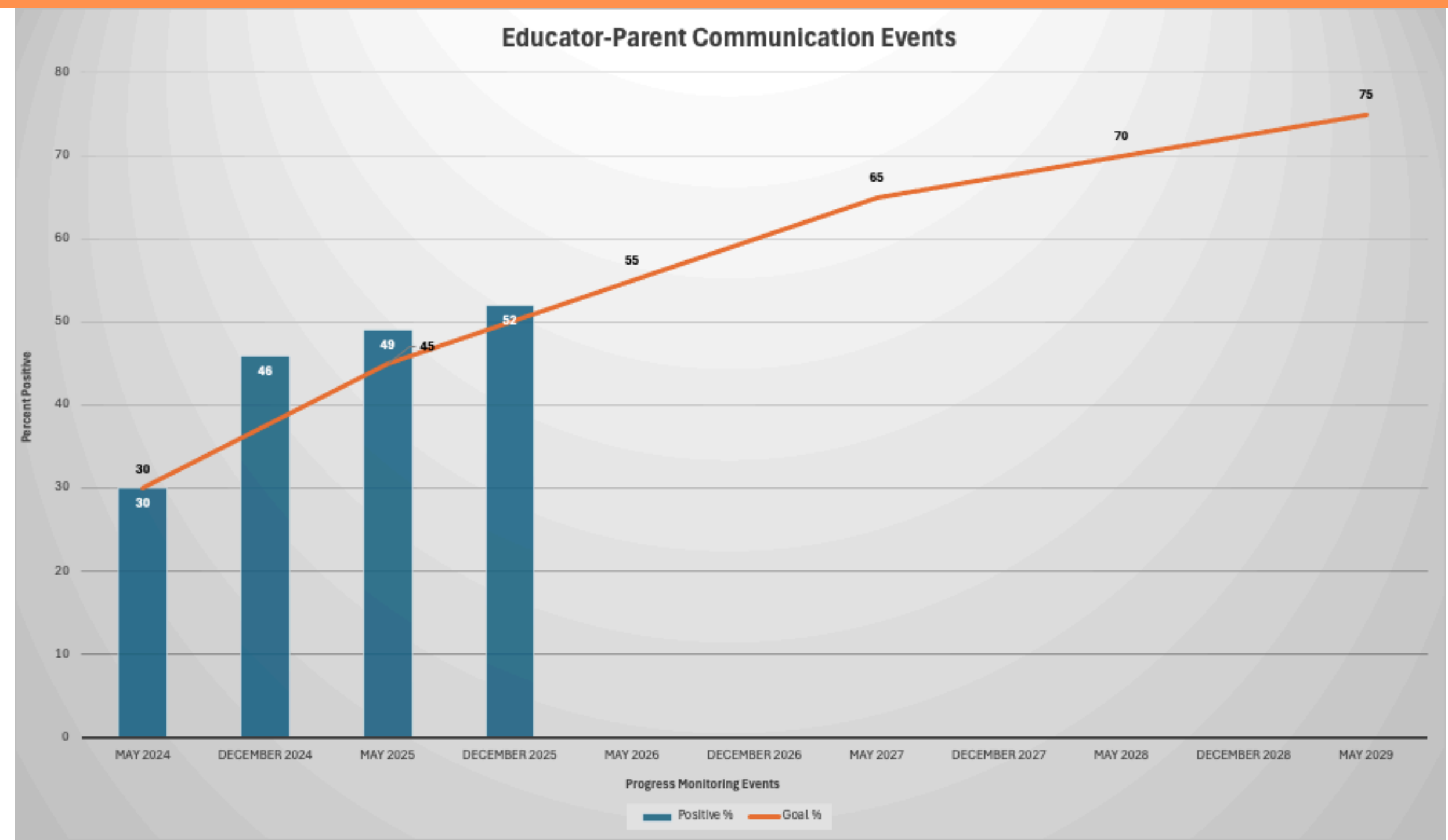




Superintendent Guardrail #3

THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOT ALLOW THE DISTRICT TO OPERATE WITHOUT AN EFFECTIVE SYSTEM OF 2-WAY COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES THAT SUPPORTS IMPROVEMENT TO STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

GPM 3.1: The percentage of communication events between educators and parents that result in a positive learning outcome as measured by teacher maintained communication logs will increase from the 30% in February 2024 to 75% in May 2029.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RESPONSE

**THE NUMBERS IN THIS REPORT ARE FROM THE 1ST SEMESTER (AUGUST-NOVEMBER).

**THE DATA IS SELF REPORTED BY EDUCATORS. ALL EDUCATORS HAVE LOGS TO COMPLETE TO DOCUMENT CONTACTS MADE WITH PARENTS AND THE RESULT OF EACH CONTACT (+, -, 0). .

**14 HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATORS MADE 589 CONTACTS WITH 296 RESULTING IN POSITIVE RESULTS (50%).

**13 ELEMENTARY EDUCATORS MADE 637 CONTACTS WITH 341 RESULTING IN POSITIVE RESULTS (54%).

**WE'RE SLOWLY CREEPING UP OUR PERCENTAGE OF POSITIVE CONTACTS. HOWEVER, WE WILL LIKELY MISS OUR GOAL IN MAY AS OUR RATE OF GROWTH HAS SLOWED IN THE LAST YEAR.

WHAT'S NEXT

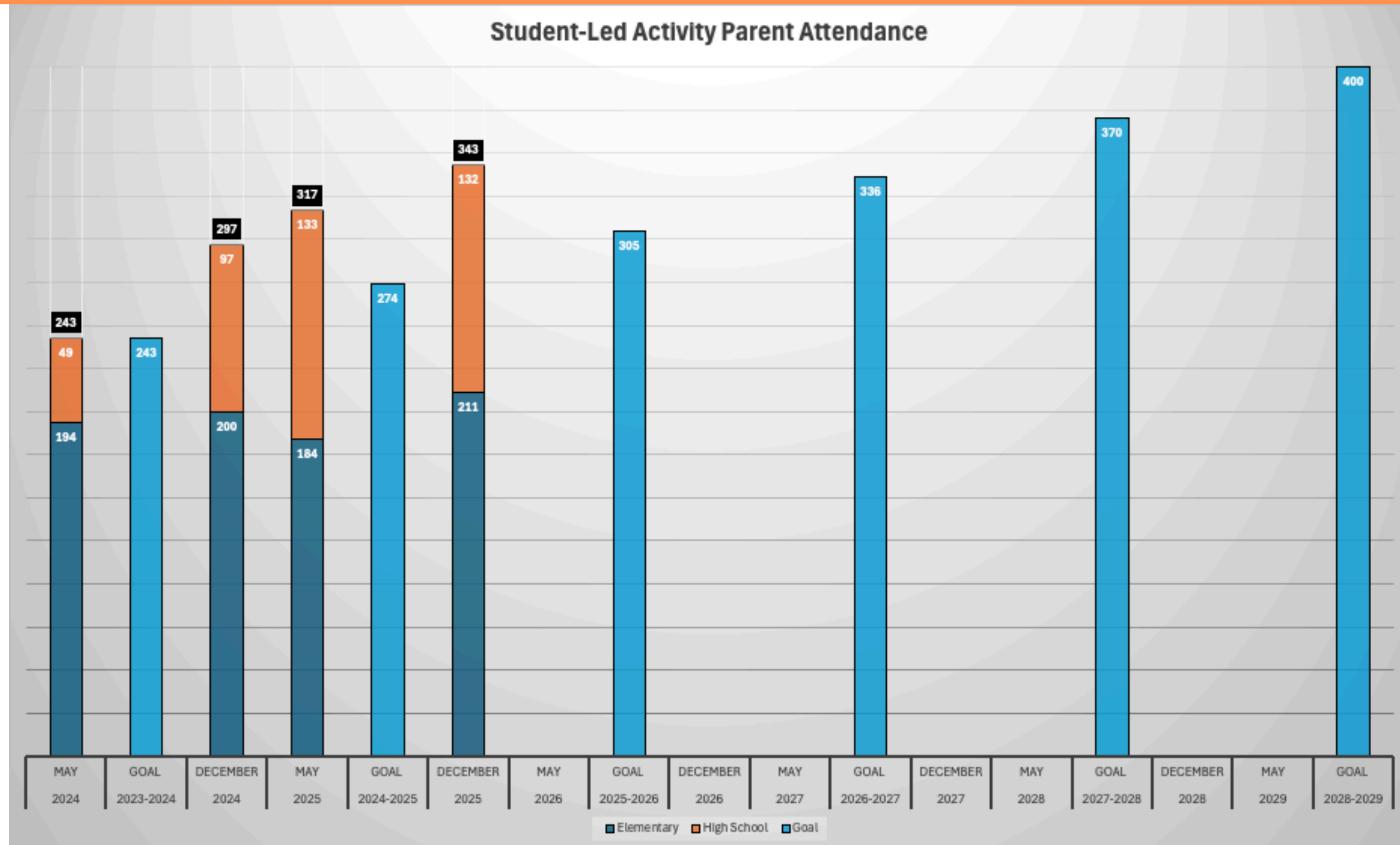
**THE NEXT PROGRESS MEASURE EVENT WILL BE THE AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR AND WILL INCLUDE THE MONTHS OF DECEMBER-MAY.

**REACHING OUR GOAL IN MAY WILL REQUIRE A CONCERTED EFFORT BY OUR ADMIN AND STAFF TO REACH OUT AND CREATE MORE COMMUNICATION OPPORTUNITIES.

**TEACHERS CONTINUE TO NOT REPORT RESULTS OF COMMUNICATION EVENTS...WE NEED TO FIND A MECHANISM TO ENSURE THAT WE HAVE TIGHTER EXECUTION OF OUR REPORTING.

**UNFORTUNATELY, A SUBSET OF TEACHERS PRODUCES MORE CONTACTS CONSISTENTLY THAN OTHERS. I WILL BE TASKING THE ADMIN. WITH WORKING WITH THOSE THAT LAG BEHIND AND FERRETING OUT THE REASON FOR THEIR LACK OF CONTACTS...BE IT REPORTING OR THE ACT OF COMMUNICATING.

GPM 3.2: The number of students that participate in a student-led activity with at least one parent/guardian will increase from 243 in May 2024 to 400 in May 2029

**THIS YEAR WE ARE NOT HOLDING PARENT CONFERENCES, INSTEAD WE ARE HOLDING STUDENT SHOWCASE EVENTS.

**THIS FALL WE SAW AN AMAZING INCREASE OF PARTICIPATION BY PARENTS COMPARED TO LAST FALL WHEN WE HELD PARENT CONFERENCES.

**132 (63%) OF OUR 7-12 STUDENTS ATTENDED THE EVENT WITH AT LEAST 1 PARENT.

**211 (92%) OF OUR K-6 STUDENTS ATTENDED THE EVENT WITH AT LEAST 1 PARENT.

WHAT'S NEXT

**OUR NEXT PROGRESS MEASURE EVENT FOR GUARDRAIL PM 3.2 WILL BE AT OUR SPRING SHOWCASE IN LATE APRIL.

**ALL STUDENTS K-12 WILL PARTICIPATE AGAIN IN THE SHOWCASE THIS YEAR.

**THE PRINCIPALS WILL BE WORKING WITH THEIR STAFF TO PLAN WHAT THIS EVENT WILL LOOK LIKE....IT WILL BE DIFFERENT DEPENDING ON GRADE LEVEL.
