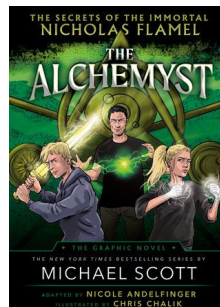
EPSILON BETA MITTEN TREE

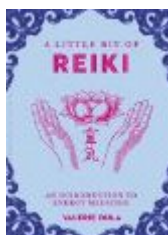

Creating a new custom Gem

- Navigate to Gems: Go to gemini.google.com and find "Explore Gems" in the side panel.
- Click "New Gem": This will open a new window for you to define your custom Gem.
- Name your Gem: Give your Gem a descriptive name (e.g., "Meeting Prep Strategist").
- Write instructions: This is the most important step. Tell the Gem its persona, the task to perform, what information to use, and the desired output format. You can add context by uploading files here.
- Save: Click "Create" or "Save" to finalize the Gem. It will now appear in your list of custom Gems.
