3D PRINTER

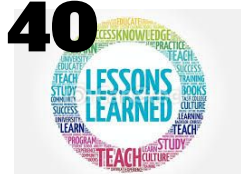

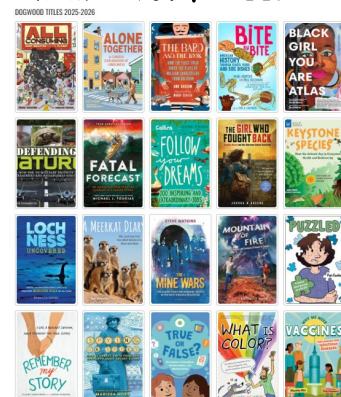

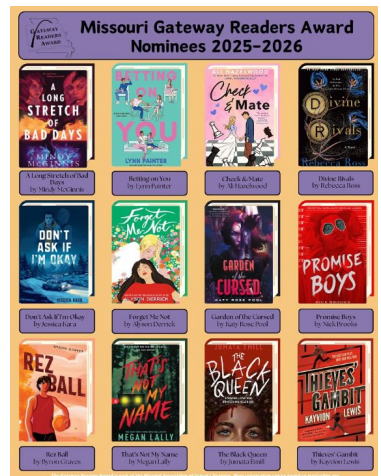
EPSILON BETA NEWS
