### GARDEN ACTIVITIES

Children learn about bees, flowers, beneficial and harmful insects, birds, and will plant and tend a native garden.

## CHILDREN'S GARDEN PROGRAM

Master Gardener Association of Cape Cod operates a seasonal Children's Garden at the Brewster Community Garden.

This free program offers children ages 8-12 a hands-on opportunity to learn about gardening. Each child is paired with a Master Gardener who provides guidance and coaching. All seeds & plants are provided to the children by the Master Gardeners. Through the summer, children enjoy harvesting and sharing all the veggies & flowers they grow!



## CHILDREN'S GARDEN SCHEDULE

The Children's Garden program will run from the first week of May through August, 3:30 p.m.- 5:00 p.m.

Children attend on either Tuesday or Thursday and you may indicate your preference on the application.

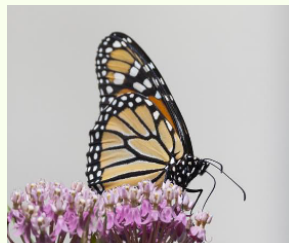
During each session, children plant and tend to their individually assigned garden plots, participate in a 20 minute group lesson on topics ranging from soil composition to pollinators, and join other activities, including making scarecrows and garden "show-and-tells".



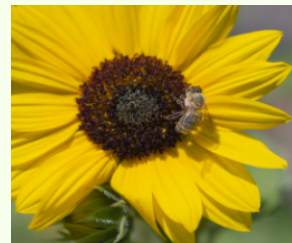
