Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by Mrs. Wilson at 5:08 PM when we reached quorum.

Action Items

Ms. Dunn moved to approve agenda. Ms. Jones seconded the motion. No nays.

Minutes moved for approval by Mrs. Dunn with second by Ms. Robinson with correction on the information shared by the budget committee on the charter dollars about the copy machines. It should not have been under an action item, but should have been moved to a discussion item.

Informational Items

Community Outreach Committee Update:

Mrs. Taylor shared update on community outreach that we received shout from EP council on cluster night.

Mrs. Wilson shared that we were awarded an AED machine from the EP police from the proceeds from the speeding camera.

Budget & Finance Committee Update:

Jones gave budget update on fundraisers. Possibly doing double good fundraiser twice a year in October and February with flyer marketing with TCHS teacher to do graphics. Possibly do an incentive for teacher participation similar to PBIS tiers with donation letters ready for teachers to use. Talked about inhouse field trips possibly twice a year connected to local colleges; reaching out to GA State and Clark Atlanta to get those started.

Discussion Items:

SGC Parent/Teacher SGC Elections. There are two seats available on each. You can serve 4 consecutive years. Mrs. Wilson also can appoint if you don't want to run for elections. It's difficult to get parents to run, but we are required to get two parents to run. Need 1 parent but preferably two so we can have an election. People who will be engaged. Ms. Dunn asked if they use QR Code, we won't hear until February 28th? Mrs. Wilson shared that Ms. Foster should be sharing informational updates with us before that.

Mrs. Wilson shared that we need to discuss Spring Committee Meetings. Ms. Dunn shared that we discussed plans for committee meeting, but not a schedule. Mrs. Wilson shared she would love to have an additional, in-person meeting.

Informational Items

Mrs. Wilson shared the PDW budget which is due Friday. We are at a zero balance for the FY27. Use charter dollars and Title I Parent Engagement funds to deepen community connections. \$23,281.00 increase in Title I funds from this year to purchase more coaches and deans. No questions.
