## Advisory Council

1 hour, 3x a year

Provide input to ensure curriculum remains aligned with industry standards.



## Informational Interview

1 hour

Meet with a student to discuss your career path, industry, and professional insights. This helps students gain a deeper understanding of various career fields.

## Simulated Lab

2-4 hours

Provide hands-on training for students using our industry-standard labs. Help them gain practical skills through unpredictable scenarios.

## Job Shadow

8 hours

Provide a student with an opportunity to observe your daily work routines. This allows them to explore a specific career path in a real-world environment.

## Instructor Externship

40 hours

Provide a work experience that allows instructors to apply classroom lessons to a real-world setting to build their technical abilities, professional skills and network.



## Guest Speaker

1 hour

Share your expertise and career story with a classroom of students. Inspire the next generation by providing a real-world perspective on your industry.

## Mock Business Project

1-3 hours

Collaborate with a class on a simulated business problem or project. Provide guidance and feedback as students work to develop solutions.

## School-Based Enterprise

1 hour

Collaborate with a student run enterprise to provide guidance and expertise. Help students gain knowledge about running their own business from start to finish.

## Pre Apprenticeship

Offer a structured training program that prepares students for a registered apprenticeship. This experience includes both classroom instruction and hands-on training.

## Clinical Experience

40+ hours

Provide a supervised, hands-on clinical experience for students in a healthcare setting, crucial for students pursuing a career in health sciences.

## Workplace Tour

1-2 hours

Host a group of students at your workplace to give them a tour and a first hand look of daily operations. Help them connect classroom learning to the real world.



## Competition Judging

1-3 hours

Evaluate student work on a project for a competition and offer constructive feedback. Help students improve their skills and prepare for professional expectations.



## Service Learning Project

8 hours

Provide an opportunity for students to utilize their technical skills to benefit a non-profit or the community. Partner with a classroom to work on a project that addresses a local need.

## Mock Interviews

2 hours

Conduct practice interviews with students to help them prepare for future job opportunities. Provide them with valuable feedback on their interviewing skills.



## Student Internship

60 hours

Offer students paid or unpaid experience that helps students develop their professional skills and technical expertise to prepare for future careers.
