

Application Window: January 1 – March 23, 2026

Acceptance Timeline

- Placement decisions will be determined by lottery on March 23rd
- Students will be e-mailed acceptance status on March 30th
- High schools will be sent accepted lists the 1st week of April

Eligibility

- Rising juniors or seniors
- On track for graduation
- Minimum 2.0 GPA (2.5 for Nursing)

DE Schedule

- Students attend PTC for the equivalent of three elective periods
- Most programs: 7:00–9:30 a.m.
- EMT: 11:00 a.m.–1:30 p.m.

Application Process

- Students apply online at <https://dualenrollment.myptc.edu/>
- Counselors and parents receive permission forms via email for all applications these must be submitted
- Counselors need to verify that students meet the eligibility requirements
 - Verify GPA
 - Send Reading and Math test scores (PSAT, SAT, ACT or PERT).
 - Submitting the permission form means you are confirming the student meets all program requirements

Information Sessions/Tours

- Attendance is optional but students are strongly encouraged to attend one of the sessions to help understand the DE experience and application process.

- 16 years of age
- Unweighted GPA of 2.0 (*exceptions noted above)
- On track for graduation
- Students must take the required admissions test at our campus if they have not taken the SAT, ACT, CLT, PERT, or PSAT Reading and Math assessments (*no minimum score required*)
