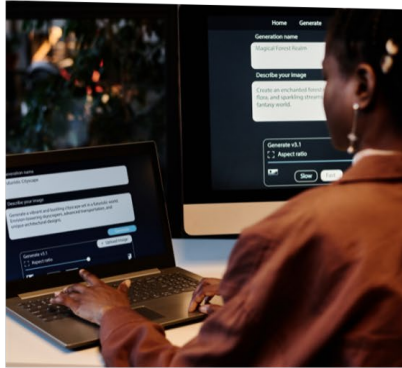
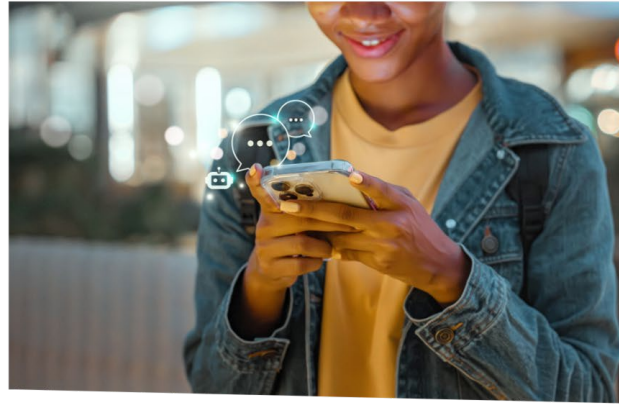

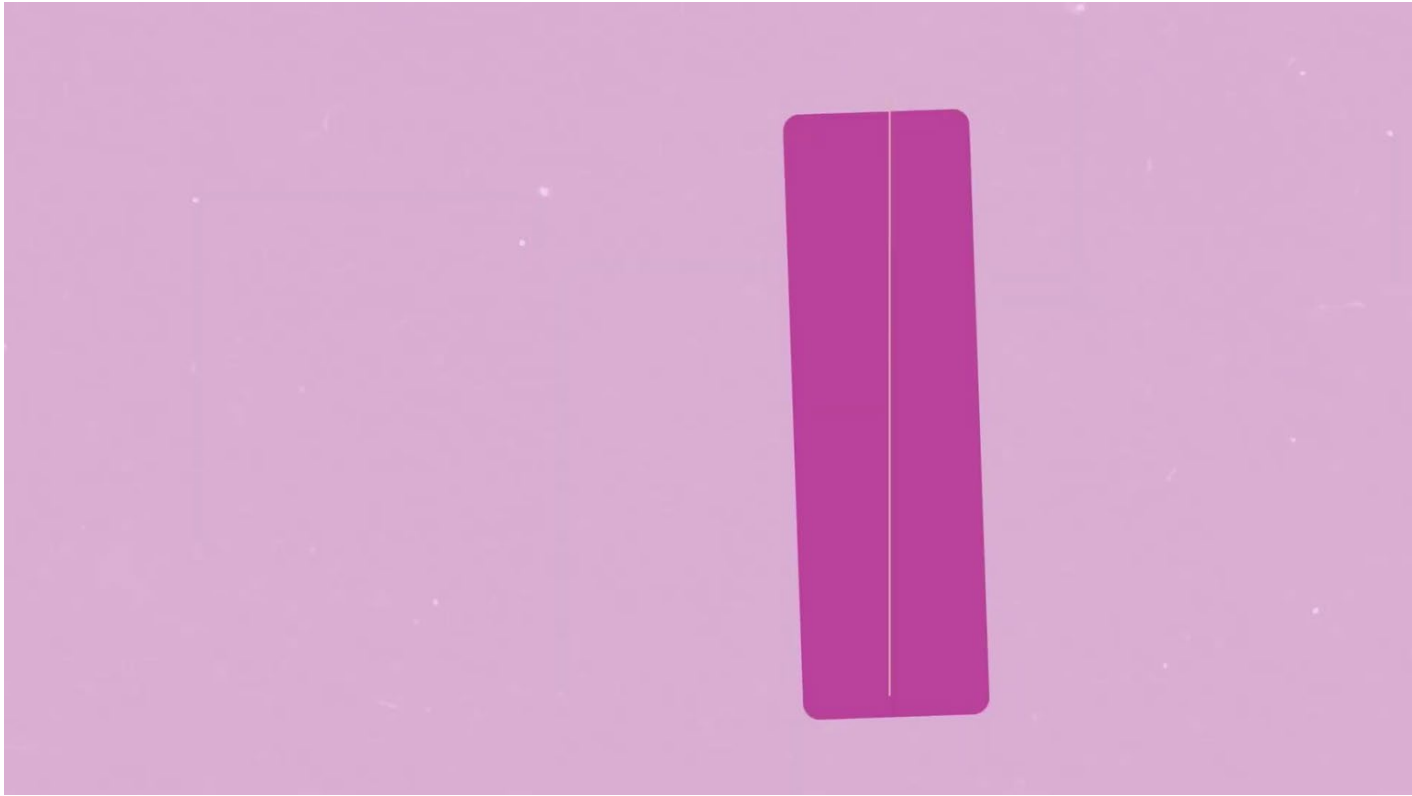
AI Literacy
