AP - means "Advanced Placement". These courses follow a curriculum set by the College Board. They tend to be very rigorous and require more homework.

DE - means "Dual Enrollment" - these are college classes offered at Deering. You will earn Deering credit AND college credit.

HR - means "Honors". These courses are more challenging and usually require more effort and homework. Some classes have honors optioned even if it isn't indicated (examples: English 1 & 4, Algebra, Environmental Science, Early US History & US & Modern World)

QTR - means "Quarter-long". These courses last only one quarter, or half of a semester.

11-12 Only - means that this class is only open to juniors and seniors, unless you get permission. If you are a sophomore wanting to take a "11-12 Only" course, please ask your school counselor to help you with the request.

PATHS - if you want to take a class at PATHS, please talk with your school counselor to set up a required visit.
