

# MAKE-UP TIME/CREDIT RECOVERY

- **Credit Recovery with Teachers:** Make-Up time with teachers before and after school may be applied towards attendance recovery. Attendance Recovery sheets can be picked up in the table outside the Attendance Office. These must be filled out and signed by the teacher hosting the recovery session, then turned in to the Attendance Office in a timely manner.
- **Saturday School:** AHS will offer multiple Saturday Schools each year from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm for students whose absences exceed the number allowed by the State of South Carolina. Attendees are required to bring work to do during that time . Transportation IS NOT provided for Saturday School.
- **Wednesday School:** AHS offers attendance recovery on select Wednesdays from 3:30–5:00. These will be announced at a later date. Bus transportation is provided if needed.

# TRUANCY

**A student under the age of 17 is TRUANT when they have 3 (three) consecutive unexcused absences, or a total of 5 (five) unexcused absences IN A SCHOOL YEAR.** If truancy occurs, parents will be contacted to arrange a conference with the Administrator to develop an **AIP** (Attendance Intervention Plan) which is in effect for one calendar year.

DURING THIS CALENDAR YEAR, AHS MAY NOT BE ABLE TO SIGN DRIVERS LICENSE FORMS ALLOWING STUDENTS TO OBTAIN THEIR LICENSE.
