We are writing to share important information regarding the upcoming **New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment- Adaptive (NJGPA-A)**, which will be administered to all **11th-grade students**.

The NJGPA-A is a **state graduation requirement** designed to measure whether students are **graduation ready** in:

- **English Language Arts (ELA)**
- **Mathematics**

The assessment is aligned to:

- **ELA:** Grade 10 New Jersey Student Learning Standards
- **Mathematics:** Algebra I and Geometry Standards

We strongly encourage all juniors to try their very best on this assessment. While we understand that testing can be stressful, effort is essential, as this assessment plays an important role in a student's path toward graduation.

Graduation Pathways

The NJGPA-A satisfies New Jersey's graduation assessment requirement. For students who do not meet the proficiency standard, the state provides **multiple pathways**, including:

- Retesting opportunities
- Approved substitute assessments
- The Portfolio Appeal process

*Students must attempt the NJGPA-A in order to be eligible for the alternative pathways!

- Students who arrive after testing has started **will not be permitted to enter** the testing location.
- Please help to ensure students arrive at school **on time**, well-rested, and ready to test.
- If your child misses one or more of the units, they will be required to take the assessment during the state scheduled make-up window (week of March 23rd). Beyond that make-up week, students would have to wait until the Fall 2026 testing window to meet this graduation requirement.
