This event is a great opportunity to learn more about our kindergarten program and get your questions answered. 2026-2027 K to First Grade Building Placements: If you have a current kindergartner, you should have received an important building placement packet in this week's Thursday Folder. Because our three Primary buildings have a different number of kindergarten classrooms, we must redistribute students as they enter first grade. This ensures that class sizes and student needs are balanced across the entire district. All current K students need a placement preference form filled out and returned to their child's teacher by Friday, February 13, 2026.

2026-2027 Building Transfer Requests (Grades 2-4): Families with students entering grades 2, 3 or 4 next year received an optional form in their Thursday folders. This form can be completed if you would like us to consider transferring your child from their current building to a different Primary building for the 2026-2027 school year. If you would like for your child to remain at their current school, you do not need to complete the form.

From the Nurse's Office: We are seeing a surge in community-wide illnesses such as influenza, covid, stomach viruses, and common cold viruses. Many of these illnesses share similar symptoms, and it can be difficult to know which one your child may have. If your child is not feeling well, we ask that you:

1. Check their temperature before sending your child to school. If they have a temperature of 100.0 °F or higher, please keep them home. Students should be fever-free for 24 hours with no fever-reducing medication (such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen) before returning to school.
2. If NO fever is present, please give medications for stomachache, headache, coughing, or other symptoms before sending them to school.
3. Students MAY NOT bring medication to school and nurses cannot give ANY medications to a student without a signed medication form.
4. If your child is fever-free, but has a stuffy/runny nose or cough, please encourage them to take precautions to limit the spread of germs until they feel better. This includes frequent hand washing or using hand sanitizer, covering their coughs, etc.
5. Students experiencing stomach virus symptoms (with or without fever) should stay home for at least 24 hours following their last episode of vomiting.
