COURSES AND CREDITS

Phoenix College

Completion of the West-MEC Medical Assisting program and the Registered Medical Assistant (RMA) certification will grant 16 college credits (at no cost), upon acceptance and enrollment into the Medical Administrative Assisting Certificate of Completion (CCL) or Medical Assistant (AAS)

RMA certification= MAS 101 Intro Med. Assisting (3 college credits)

= MAS 102 Fundamentals of Administrative Medical Assisting (6 college credits)

= MAS 103 Basic Anatomy, Physiology, and Medical Terminology (3 college credits)

= MAS 104 Medical Administrative Assisting Practicum (4 college credits)

Completion of the West-MEC Medical Assisting program and the Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) certification OR the Registered Phlebotomy Technician (RPT) certification will grant 4 college credits (at no cost), upon application, acceptance and enrollment into the Medical Laboratory Science (CCL) or (AAS).

CPT/RPT certification = PLB 109 Phlebotomy Basis Skills (2 college credits)

= PLB 111 Specimen Processing and Advanced Techniques in Phlebotomy Procedures (2 college credits)

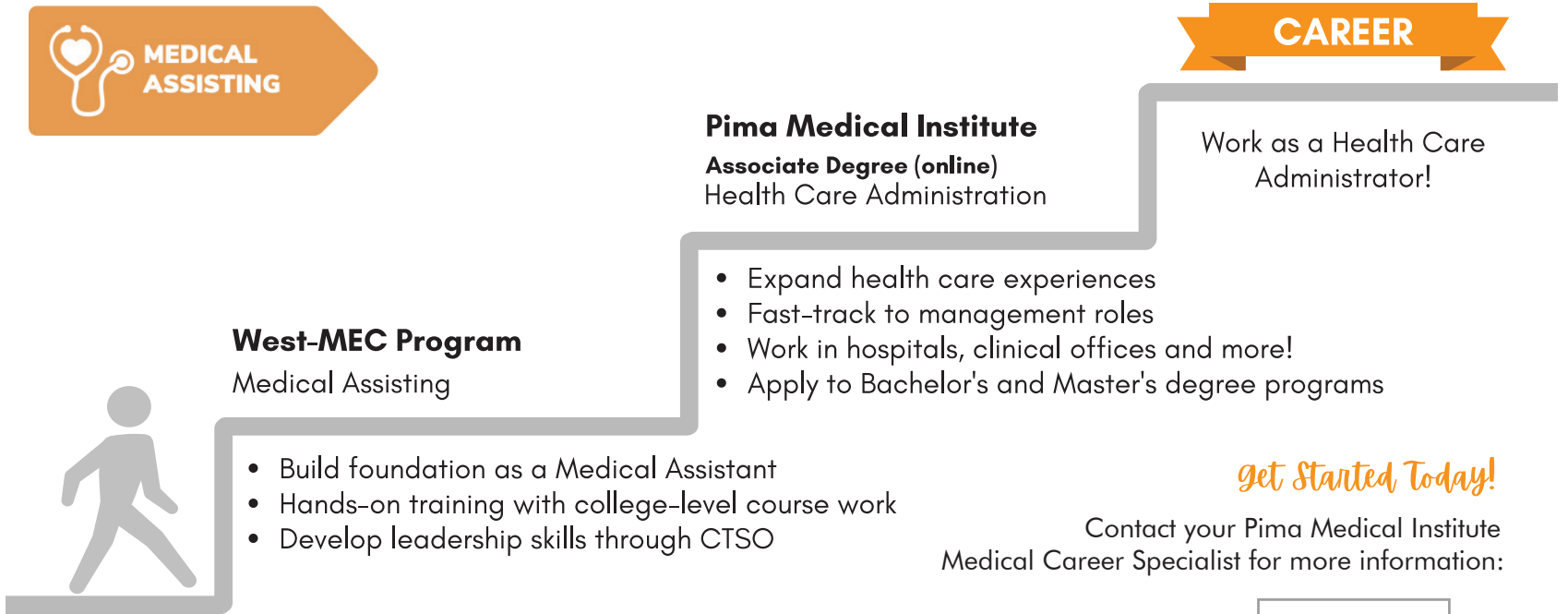
