

AU Agreement Update: Business Department collaborating with Southwest SELPA Executive Director to revise Administrative Unit agreement

Next Step: Final agreement to be presented to the board for consideration upon completion of review




Business- Upcoming Classified PD Workshop (PBIS)

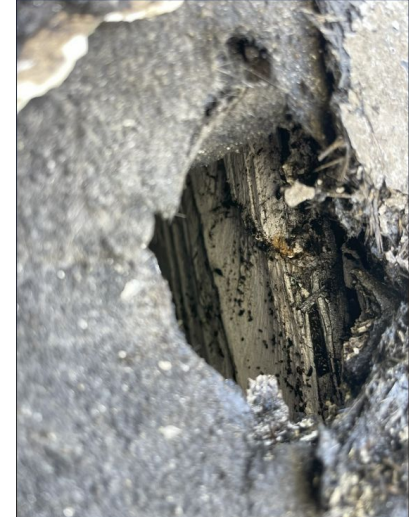
Business- Supt.'s Office Roof Leak

Area will continue to be monitored during upcoming rain events

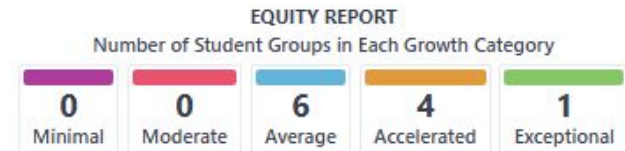
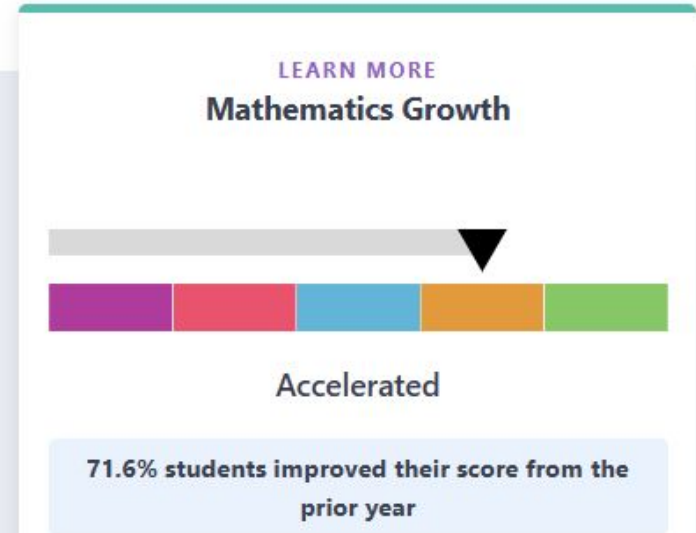
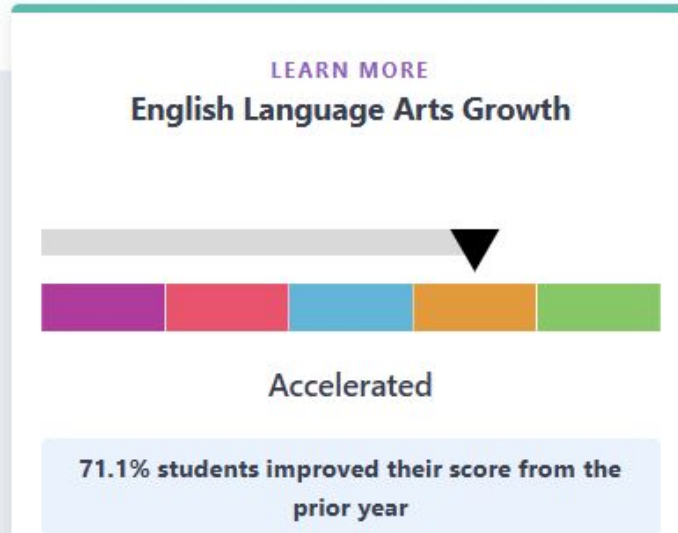

2025 CA Dashboard Growth Data

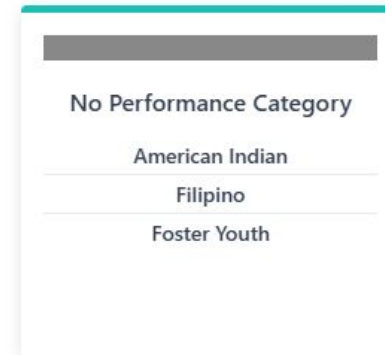
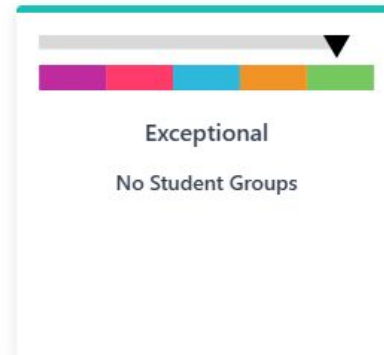
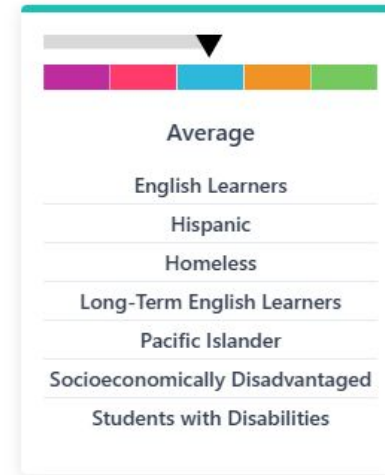
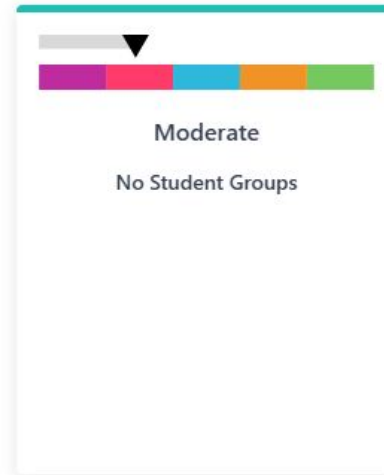
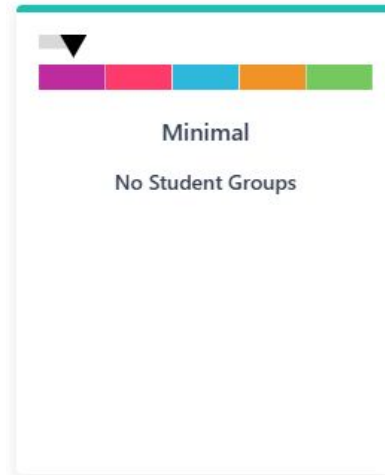

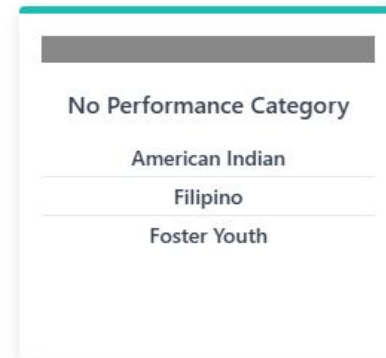
