CLASS PERIODS

Langston Hughes operates on a 4x8 scheduling system where students take four classes each day on an A-B scheduling rotation. Students take a total of eight courses each semester. Credit is awarded every 18 weeks (0.5 credits per course) with a maximum of 8 credits earned during the regular school year.
