WHY ASHES?

For centuries Catholic Christians have marked the beginning of the season of Lent by receiving ash on their foreheads on Ash Wednesday. This tradition has its roots in the Old Testament, where wearing ashes was a common sign of repentance for sins, and a sign of one's humility before God. Since Lent is a season of penitential renewal through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, it's appropriate that this ancient sign marks the beginning of the season.

Ashes are usually distributed as part of a Mass or Liturgy of the Word on Ash Wednesday, often after the homily. As people approach the minister, ash is pressed on your forehead, and he speaks: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," or "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

In many churches, Ash Wednesday services are among the most popular of the whole year. Cynics have suggested that this is because people "get" something, as they do on Palm Sunday. But there's nothing particularly appealing about being smudged with ashes. Perhaps, the appeal is the expression through a physical sign of a desire for interior conversion.

The Gospel for Ash Wednesday is a reminder that the real purpose of the season of Lent isn't to make public demonstrations of piety—even the wearing of ashes—but to seek conversion of heart. (Fr. Larry Rice, USCCB, Fact of Faith)

NO FLOWERS DURING LENT

As part of our Lenten observance, we refrain from decorating the church with flowers. That includes not only the Church and Chapel, but also the Narthex. If it is your custom to place flowers at any of the statues, please refrain until after Easter.

We are forming our 2026 Triduum Choir. This choir is a part of the Triduum Liturgy, singing on Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday of the Passion of the Lord and the Great Easter Vigil. El salmo responsorial de hoy nos dice: “Bienaventurados aquellos que siguen la ley del Señor”. Al respecto, San Francisco de Sales nos explica lo siguiente:

¿Cómo seguir la “ley del SEÑOR” para vivir de mejor manera? Primero, debemos purificar todas nuestras intenciones tanto como nos sea posible. Debemos hacer el firme propósito de aprovechar el día de la mejor manera para que nuestra intención de vivir bien sea de conformidad con los designios de Dios. Debemos anticipar aquellas tareas, interacciones y sucesos que harán parte de nuestro día, y que representan oportunidades para servir a Dios. ¿A qué tipo de tentaciones se verán expuestos? ¿A la ira, al amor egoísta o a otro tipo de caprichos? Prepárense cuidadosamente para evitar, resistir, y vencer cualquier obstáculo que les impida vivir a Jesús verdaderamente.

Para que puedan seguir la ley del Señor, lo primero que deben hacer es un propósito sagrado de crecer en el amor que Jesús nos enseñó. Con el fin de prepararse para poner en práctica ese propósito, pídanle a nuestro Salvador que los ayude a utilizar los medios a su disposición para crecer en el amor sagrado y para poder servirlo de la mejor manera posible. Admitan que ustedes solos no pueden llevar a cabo la decisión de alejarse del mal y de hacer el bien tal y como Dios desea que lo hagan. Tomen sus corazones en sus manos y ofrézcanse a nuestro Salvador junto con todas sus buenas intenciones. Pídanle que se encargue de proteger y de fortalecer sus corazones para que así ustedes puedan avanzar en Su amor verdadero.

Para que puedan seguir la ley del Señor deben aprender a orar. Deben recibir los sacramentos con frecuencia. A medida que se dedican a realizar las tareas propias de sus vocaciones, nunca olviden poner en práctica la humildad, la gentileza, la

paciencia y la sencillez; virtudes que crecen como flores al pie de la Cruz.

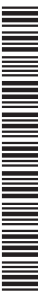
