- *convertirse en padres líderes que sirven de enlace entre el DPAC y el SSC, asegurando la comunicación y la información bidireccionales.*

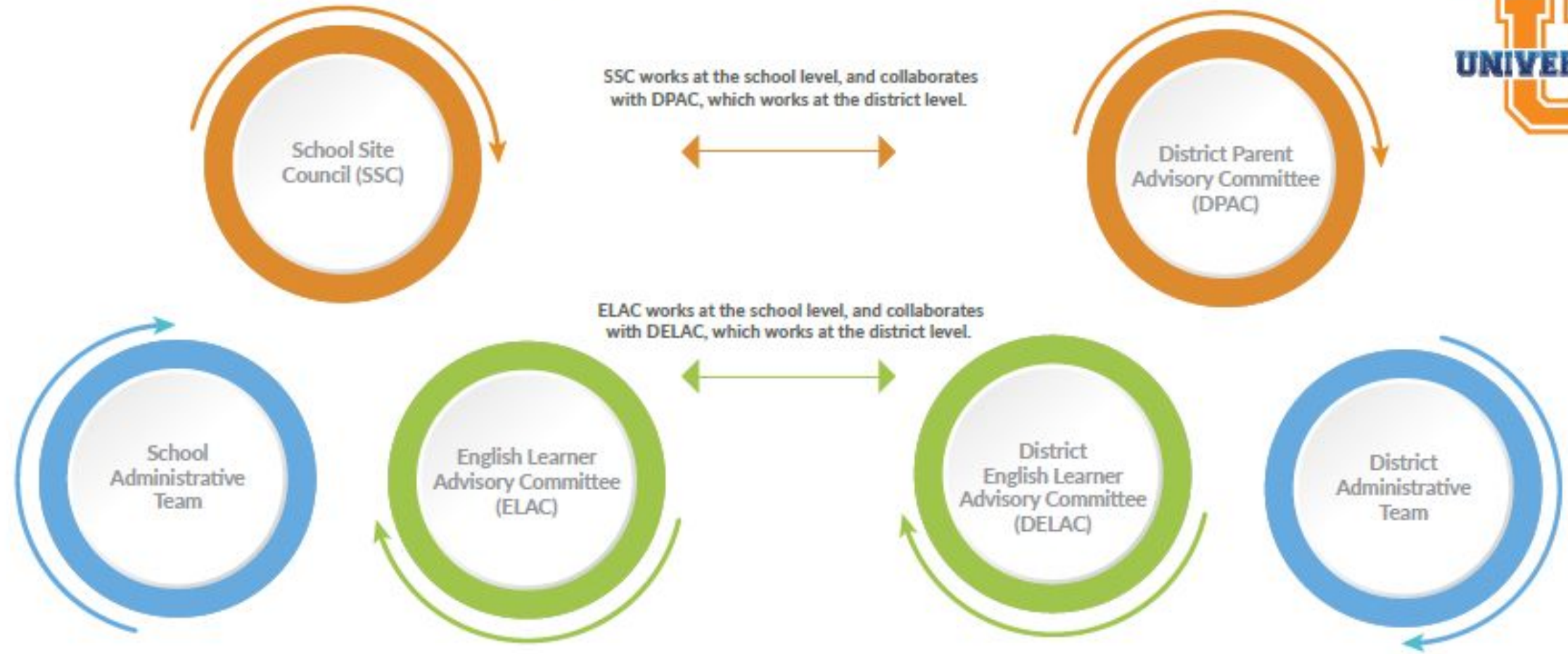

Nomination procedures

Procedimientos de nominación

- A person can nominate himself, herself, or someone else
- The person nominated can accept or decline the nomination
- All accepted nominations will be listed on the nomination slate and shared in the minutes
- Nominees will have 3 minutes each to tell the committee why they should be selected
- Una persona puede nominarse a sí misma o a otra persona
- La persona nominada puede aceptar o rechazar la nominación

Step 1: Get Tuberculosis (TB) test results from a medical provider, dated within the last 12 months. *(Required at the initial application and every 4 years thereafter.)*

Step 2: Complete the Volunteer Application and submit your TB test results.

Step 3: Once all documents are submitted, HR will contact you to complete your LiveScan.

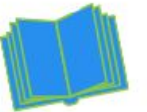
