## **WALLENPAUPACK AREA SCHOOL BOARD**

High School Assistant Principal Mrs. Delia Peppiatt introduced three seniors to the School Board that provided a summary of their experiences with their senior seminars. They highlighted events and skills that provided them real life exposure to possible future career pathways.

### Building Updates

South Elementary – Hearts Around the World project has collected 298 cards from 48 states and 21 countries.  
North Primary – Crowned the December champs for participation in the Prodigy Education app.  
North Intermediate – Counselors are leading 9 groups including the Friendship Club, the Empathy Club and more.  
Middle School – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students toured the CTE programs and have begun to request classes for next year.  
High School – 31 seniors were eligible for January graduation. FCCLA is hosting a Valentine's Dance on Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>.  
Special Education – PASA testing to start in March. Unified sports are entering into fundraising season.

Dr. Gunuskey provided an update on the Wayne/Pike CTC, noting that Representative Rob Bresnahan, Senator John Fetterman, and Senator Dave McCormick have dedicated 3 million dollars in funds to support the project.

**The Board took action to approve the N.E.I.U. #19 Proposed General Operating Budget for the 2026-2027 School Year.**
