If you are planning to participate as a walk-on in any NCAA sport at Texas A&M University, please do not mention that sport in your answers to any of the questions on the scholarship application (i.e., this is specifically designed to avoid violations of NCAA rules). However, please feel free to mention sports/activities in which you participated during your secondary education.

Scholarship applicants will be notified before the 2026 Ellis A&M Club annual Aggie Muster. This is one of many Aggie traditions, and Aggie Muster is held annually on April 21st. The Ellis A&M Club Aggie Muster program includes dinner and a program. This year, the event will be held at Park Meadows Baptist Church, located at 3550 North Highway 77, Waxahachie, Texas 75165, at 6:30 pm (doors will open at 6:00 pm). All scholarship award winners and parents will be invited as guests of the Ellis A&M Club. Any additional guests are welcome to attend for a fee, which attendees pay. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the event.

Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to Texas A&M University Financial Aid Services for distribution to each scholarship recipient. The Scholarship will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters. The spring stipend will be contingent upon the student having made satisfactory academic progress (i.e., a minimum of 12 credit hours and a GPR of 2.5 or better).

An essay is required from you that must be handwritten and no more than 1000 words (less is fine). You must scan your essay as a PDF and upload it to the application. If your essay exceeds 1000 words, you must delete some of it. Decide what you think will be most important to those reading the applications.

1. Your unofficial high school transcript.
2. Your unofficial college transcript (if applicable).
3. Your SAT or ACT report.
4. Two letters of recommendation (not family related); and
5. Handwritten Essay scanned - **(PDF Format ONLY)** – Why Texas A&M University (one page).

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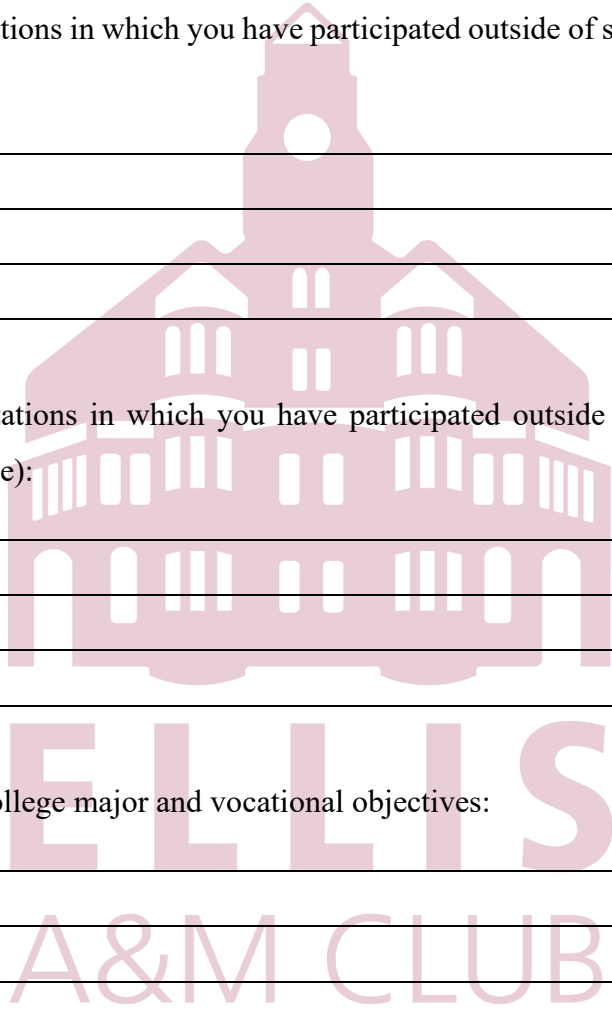
