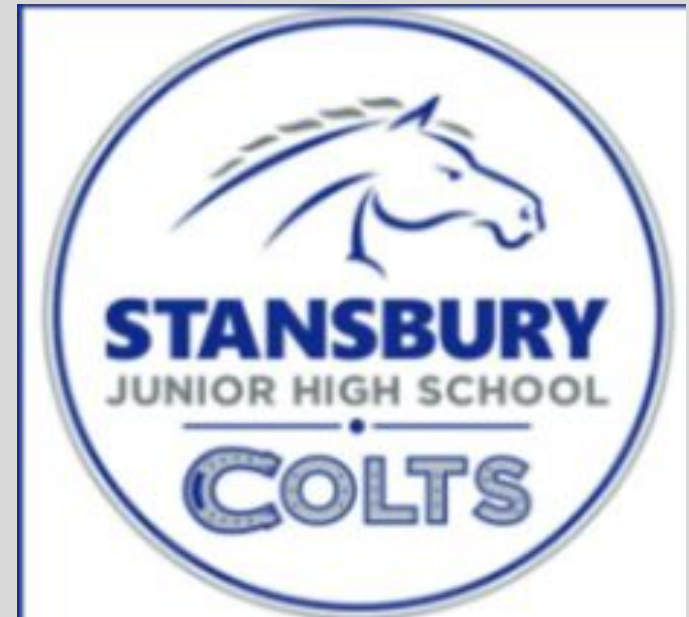



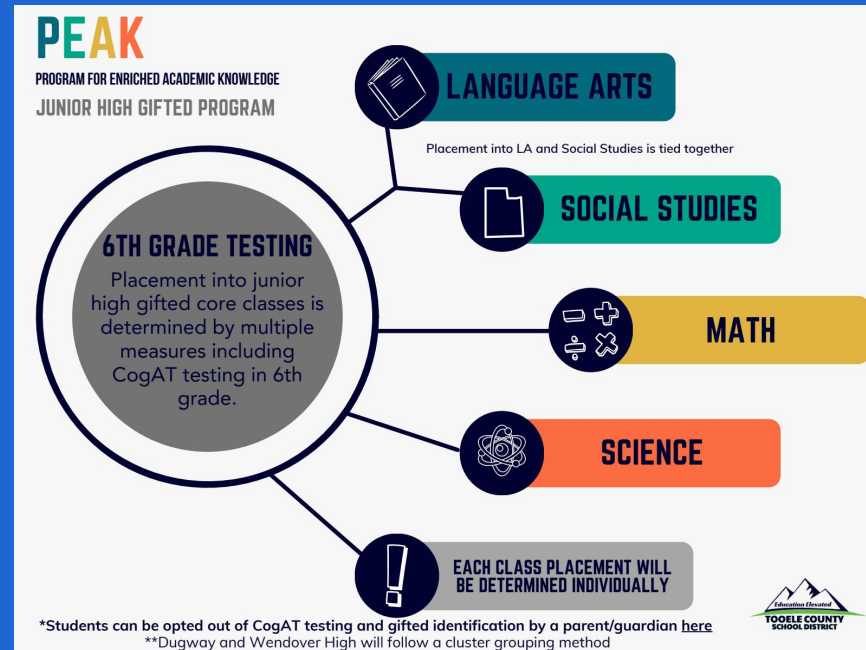

GEM Elementary
GEM is TCSD's elementary gifted program designed to serve the needs of our younger gifted and talented students in 3rd to 6th grade.
This program pulls out students one hour a week to offer challenging content and activities to enrich their educational experience and promote academic excellence. Students are identified at the end of 2nd grade or when new to TCSD.

PEAK Junior High
The purpose of PEAK is to provide an enriched and rigorous educational experience to meet the academic needs for Jr. high students that have been identified as gifted and talented.
Courses:
• Math
• Science
• ELA tied with social studies
Students are identified for each of the three content areas separately, which means it is possible to be in zero, one, two, or all courses depending on displayed academic needs.

AP/CE High School
Advanced Placement (AP) and Concurrent Enrollment (CE) courses are available to all students. They are the best option for high-achieving students to take advanced coursework and begin earning college credits.
AP courses are meant to be more rigorous than general courses and require passing an end-of-year AP test with a score of 3 or higher (out of 5) in order to earn college credit.
CE courses are actual college classes offered through partnerships with Utah public colleges that are taught on our high school campuses by our staff or broadcast by university and college faculty. Grades in these courses are recorded on both high school and college transcripts.

Backpack Policy

From the Student Handbook:

- ▶ Students can have and carry a backpack from class to class throughout the school day. Be cautious how much you put in your backpack, so it is not a burden/distraction to carry around throughout the day.
- ▶ Backpacks must be able to be carried on shoulders, no rolling backpacks are allowed. Backpacks can be easily stowed, each desk has a backpack hook on it for hanging them.
- ▶ All such bags are subject to search.



Cell Phones, Smartwatches, and Personal Devices

Cell phones and/or smart watches may be brought to school with parents' permission but must be turned off and stored in backpacks during school hours while student is on campus.

Cell phones or smart watches are not to be used by students during school hours or on school grounds including recess to call or text out. The office phone is available for students when necessary and with permission during the school day. TCSD cannot assume any responsibility for personal devices.

Exceptions may be made for students with a health care plan (such as students with a continuous glucose monitor), IEP or 504. This will be approved on a case-by-case basis by meeting with the principal, teacher, and case manager.



Immunizations



The state of Utah now mandates that all 7th grade students be fully immunized by the 1st day of school.



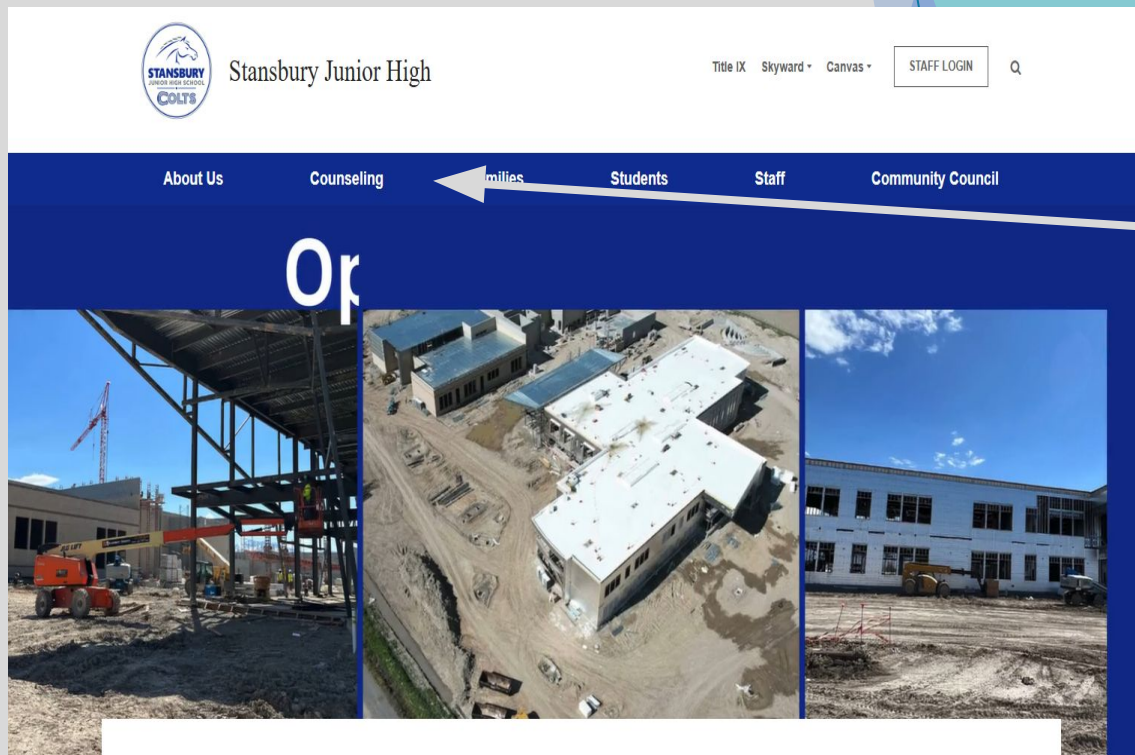
For most students, this means receiving the 1 Tdap, 2 Varicella (Chickenpox) and 1 Meningococcal shot.



We will need verification or a **new exemption form** by August 18, 2025 so you will be ready to start school on August 18th.
