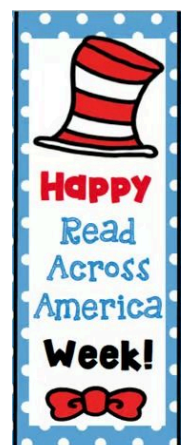
## Bookmark Design Contest: March 2-13

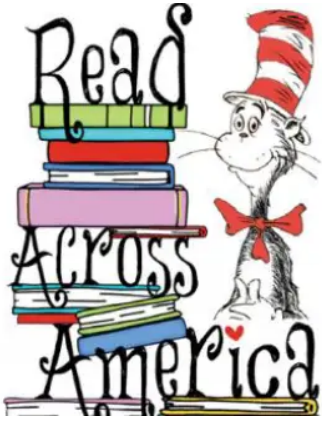

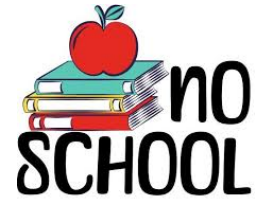
