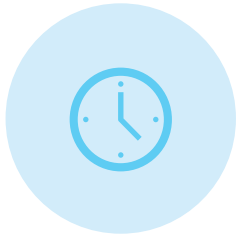

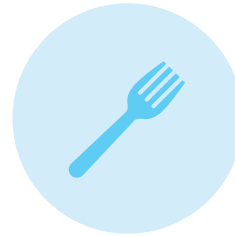
A Day in the Life of a 6th Grader
