All registration will take place online through Skyward Family Access. Courses will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

 - Current open-enrolled students are eligible to register at the same time as residents.
- Non-Resident Enrollment begins March 20th

She will provide you with information on how to enroll your child through New Student Online Enrollment. Once enrollment is approved, you will receive a confirmation email which will include instructions on how to register for courses.

Important: Students will not be able to repeat the same class across sessions (ex: Gym Games) unless there is room. EXCEPTION: Each session covers different letters and sounds, so families may register for Sound Beginnings once per session.

TRANSPORTATION

NURSING SERVICES

There will be a Health Room Aide available to assist students with health-related needs such as first aid and medication administration during the day and hours of summer school. If a child becomes ill or injured while at school, parents/guardians will receive a phone call to pick up the child or to inform the parents/guardians that the child has been transported to a medical facility.

FEES

Summer school is free for all Waterford Graded School District residents and students enrolled in Waterford Graded Schools. Some courses require a materials fee, which is noted in the course description. Non-resident tuition cost is \$80 per two-week class.

Any tuition and material fees must be paid by June 14th, 2026. Fees can be paid on eFunds through the Skyward Family Access portal or at the District Office located at 819 W. Main Street. Unpaid fees may result in your student losing their spot in class.

If you have registered your child(ren) and they will not be attending summer school, contact Heidi Frost at frost@waterford.k12.wi.us. Refunds will only be given if the student is withdrawn prior to the first day of summer school. No refunds will be given after June 16th, 2026.

SOUND BEGINNINGS
