



Summer CAMPS

Join us for Anthony Adventures Summer Day Camp! We are offering full day camp sessions for TAS students entering PreK4-4th grades. Students must be enrolled at The Anthony School for the 2026-2027 school year.

Get ready for loads of fun and learning as we enjoy water play, science experiments, arts & crafts, fitness & physical activity, game-based learning and more! In addition to enrolling in our day camp, students can enroll in enrichment camps which are taught by TAS staff and parents at various times.

Registration for Day Camp

Anthony Adventures Day Camp is open to students entering PreK4 through 4th grade from 7:30 am - 5:00 pm. Full-time Day Camp is \$230 each week.

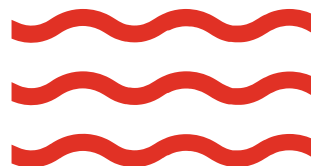
Registration for Enrichment Camps

- Your Day Camp registration does NOT automatically enroll you in Enrichment Camps.
- Please note: while Day Camp is open to PreK4-4th grade, Enrichment Camps are available for a wider age range.
- We encourage you to register for both Day Camps and Enrichment Camps. If you register your child for an Enrichment Camp during the same week that you also register for Day Camp, you will receive a \$50 refund (if you register for two Enrichment Camps during the same week you register for a Day Camp, you will receive a \$100 refund). Refunds will be issued back to your credit card. These refunds will be issued within 3 business days of the start of the enrichment camp.
- We will continue to enroll students in all camps until all the spots are filled.



Drop-off/Pick-up

- Students not picked up by 5:00 p.m. will be charged a late fee of \$5 per minute. If you suspect you may be late to pick up your child, please call or text the Camp Director, Amanda Taylor at 501-680-6216.
- NO student may be dropped off before 7:30 a.m.
- Every student must be signed in by their adult guardian at the start of their camp session and signed out by their adult guardian at the end of their session.



Conduct

The Anthony School does not tolerate behaviors that do not promote the best experience for all participants and staff. We expect that the following major rules will be consistently followed by all participants:

- No fighting or physical violence
- No bullying, teasing, or making fun of other participants
- No inappropriate language
- No endangering the health and safety of self, other participants, or staff
- No damaging or stealing property

Student conduct expectations for Day Camp are the same as those during the school year. All applicable handbook policies will continue to be in place during Day Camp sessions. The TAS Student Handbook can be found under the Parent Resources page on the school website. Any student not abiding by TAS behavioral standards may be removed from Day Camp pending a conference with the Camp Director, Head of School and/or Assistant Head of School and parents of the student. Any dismissal from camp as a result of behavior issues will not be given a refund.

Lunch and Snacks

- Campers should bring two healthy snacks each day in addition to a lunch from home (with drink).
- Please send a **labeled** water bottle with your Day Camper each day! We have several bottle filling stations throughout the campus.
- Summer lunches will be available for purchase through Bella's Kitchen & Wellness. More details can be provided to you, if interested.

Napping

- PreK4 Day Campers will nap each day from 12:15 pm until 2:15 pm.
- Nap mats, pillows and blankets may be kept at school for the duration of each week. These materials will be sent home each Friday to be washed and returned to school the following Monday (or upon the Day Camper's next return).



Toileting/Change of Clothes

PreK4 and Kindergarten Day Campers will need to provide an extra set of clothes at the start of camp. In the event of accidents, students must be able to change their own clothes.



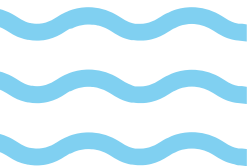
Health Information

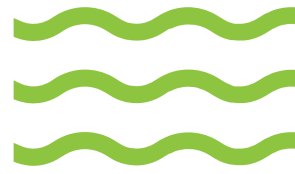
- The School Nurse will not be on campus during the Summer Camp session.
- Students taking prescription medications must turn in a new **Permission for Medication Administration Form** before the first day of the summer session. A trained staff member will administer medications.
- Medications may only be administered to students only when the medication is scheduled to be dispensed at a specific time during camp hours.
- **Self-Carry and Administration Forms** from the previous school year will be valid until the end of the summer session. It will be the parent's responsibility to have their child's EpiPen or inhaler available and up-to-date if applicable.
- All medications provided by parents for the summer session must be turned in on the first day of their session to Amanda Taylor, Director of Programming, and picked up by the last day of camp. Any medication not picked up will be disposed of according to state law.



Payments & Payment Plans

Please pay by credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover) via Sawyer. Within Sawyer, you can either pay in full or select a payment plan if you are registering before June 1. Please log in to your Sawyer account and complete all registration information and forms.





Cancellations/Withdrawals

With email notification to the Director of Extended Day Programming, Mady Deaton, (madyd@anthonyschool.org), families may withdraw a participant from a summer day or enrichment camp under the following scenarios:

- Cancellation of the camp more than or equal to 3 weeks from the start of your scheduled camp: You will receive a refund less 20% of the camp fee.
- Cancellation of the camp less than 3 weeks away: You will receive a refund less 50% of the camp fee.

Participants who commence a summer session late, depart early, or miss days (whether due to violation of rules, for medical reasons, or at the election of the camper or family) will not receive any refund, proration, credit, or tuition reduction.

The Anthony School reserves the right to cancel any camp due to under enrollment or unforeseen circumstances. Participants will be given the choice of selecting another camp or receiving a full refund of paid fees. The instructors of Enrichment Camps reserve the right to cancel if the camp attendance minimum is not met; if this occurs, you will receive a full refund.
