### **Registration Process**

**You can register online through the ISD 191 Community Education website via the Arux Community Portal. The process includes:**

**Selection:** Choose your desired child care program.

**Information:** Enter emergency contacts and answer required questions.

**Scheduling:** Select specific schedules and contracts.

**Payment:** Submit required payment information.

### **Status & Approval**

**Pending Status:** After submission, you will see a confirmation page. Your request will remain in "pending approval" status while being processed. Processing may take up to 5 business days.


**Official Notification:** Registration is only complete once you receive an automated email confirming that your contract has been approved. The registration fee will be processed at the time of approval.

**Note:** Registration is typically accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, space permitting.

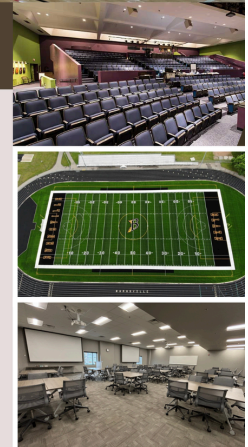
