## August 2024:

Perrin Elementary opened in a new subdivision (Wildflower Ranch).

## August 2025:

Based on 2024-2025 STAAR results, Perrin Elementary was identified as “Targeted School Improvement” by TEA based on accountability score: 59 (F)
