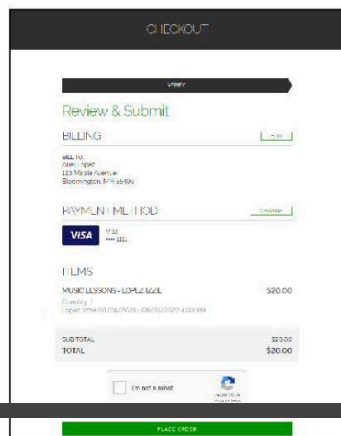

#### **Reading Explorers**

**Grade(s): 1 - 2**
