



5. EDC Projects Report – Chad Kuzontkoski

Mr. Kuzontkoski distributed his written report which summarized the activities in the Light Industrial, Commercial and Town Center Village District zones for the month, noting that the Suffield Hardware addition project and the Kitchen and Floor Store project are finished and are notable examples of projects in large part financed by the EDC TIF grant. There was discussion about approaching other businesses in the district to consider projects with high visibility.

Mr. Kuzontkoski noted that the “Taste of Suffield” restaurant promotion is going on through April 1<sup>st</sup> where people can send their receipts in from two restaurants to be entered into a drawing to win a gift card to a local restaurant of their choice.

Mr. Girard updated the Commission on the conceptual plans for 250 apartments that was brought before Planning and Zoning at their February 9<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting. The meeting was recorded and is on the Town website. The power point will be sent out to members so they can have a better understanding of the scope of the proposal. It is in a preliminary stage and more study will be done on the specifics and the impact on the Town. Members agreed that it would definitely have economic development impact.
