The School & Community

Valley Christian High School has been partnering with Christian families in the greater Los Angeles area since 1935. We continue to operate on the belief that the collaboration of church, home and school provides young people with the support they need to grow in virtue, wisdom, and godliness. Our student body consists of 530 students that come from the surrounding area and represents over 200 churches. We are proud of the diversity that makes our community unique. We provide a wide range of opportunities for students in performing arts, robotics, athletics, music, visual arts and more. Our hope is for every student that walks our halls to leave a bit more like Christ! There are 30 full-time and 8 part-time faculty members. Although it accepts students of all ability levels, VCHS offers a comprehensive program that is strongly college preparatory.

Calendar & Schedule

Courses meet four times per week on a modified block schedule. Progress grades are given two times a semester; permanent grades are given at the end of each semester following exams. Each semester course is granted 0.5 units.

Service Requirement

As part of the missions of Valley Christian High School, we believe that it is important for students to learn to live in gratitude for the abundance of blessings God has given them. Learning avenues of service as well as developing habits of servant-hood are important Christian virtues. Therefore, one of the graduation requirements is for each student to perform 60 hours of community service.

Advanced Placement & Honors Courses

Advanced Placement and Honors courses are open to students of high motivation and/or proven ability who wish to study a subject in greater depth. There is no limit to the number of AP or Honors courses a student may take.

AP Courses (11): Biology, Physics C, Art History, English Language, English Literature, Spanish Language, Statistics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, American Gov, US History, & World History. (2025 AP Pass Rate: 240 AP tests were given with 221 exams scoring 3 or higher - 92% pass rate)

Grading System

The VCHS gpa is cumulative, computed each semester on the basis of all courses. Grades are weighted in courses designated as Honors or Advanced Placement for grades of C- and above.

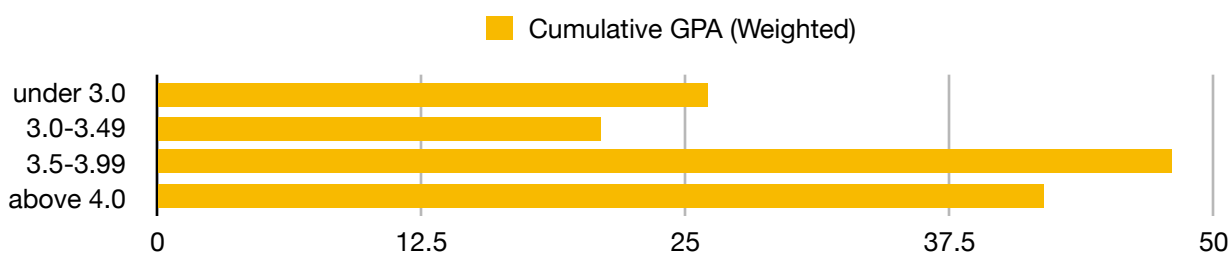

Valley Christian students are highly involved in school activities with nearly 60% in sports, and 40% in clubs and other extra curricular activities. Student Council involves 30 elected members, who in turn involve the student body in activities sponsored by the student government.
