Early Childhood Special Education Classroom

- Four (4) half days per week program for children who qualify based on an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
- Classroom supports include:
 - Speech Pathology
 - School Social Work Services
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Physical Therapy
 - School Psychologist

Troy School District Support Services

- Students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) receive support for academics, social-emotional, speech & language, fine motor, and gross motor skills.
- Multi-tiered Systems of Support: Team collaborates each week to support students and their families.
- Different service delivery models to meet student needs, including push-in, pull-out, and co-teaching.



ELD

- Students who are English language learners begin taking the WIDA screener assessment in Pre-K, which measures their proficiency in academic English.
- Students who qualify as English Learners on the screener are eligible for services from the ELD department and will maintain eligibility until placing out on the yearly assessment each Spring.
- Continue speaking to your child in the language where you can provide him or her with the richest language! Being bilingual is a tremendous asset, and children will link the new words they hear at school to the language(s) they hear at home and build on that.

Language

Each child will grow their listening and speaking development through authentic peer play episodes and quality peer and adult conversations.

Each child will engage in activities that teach and foster foundational areas of literacy knowledge, with a balance of child-initiated experiences and teacher-planned activities. Emergent and early literacy concepts are taught based on children's literacy development.

Each child will develop an understanding of communicating their ideas and thoughts through pictures and text.

HIGHSCOPE CURRICULUM



Utilizes **open-ended** materials in a carefully designed environment where children can **manipulate** and **explore** materials to foster **creativity** and **problem-solving** skills.



Authentic conversations and interactions with peers and teachers are a key components in allowing children to **express themselves** and **develop their language** skills in meaningful ways.



Teachers provide scaffolding and guidance to support children's learning based on their **individual development** needs.



Authentic assessments are based on **teacher observation** recorded over time. The content areas address key concepts in early learning. Parents and caregivers will receive reports 2-3 times within the school year.



The TSD Preschool provides high-quality, early learning activities in a nurturing environment for all students, which builds a strong foundation for a smooth transition to kindergarten. District preschool and kindergarten teachers collaborate to ensure instructional alignment from preschool to early elementary.
