New for 2026

Middle School Courses: 2026 Summer School Middle School courses will be held at the NEW Waunakee Community Middle School located at 501 South Street.

Summer School Contact Information: Beginning in Summer 2026, the Waunakee Community School District will use summer school-specific contact groups to communicate important information with families. When registering for summer school, families will be asked to provide an email address and cell phone number. This contact information entered during the summer school registration process will be the primary method used for all summer school communications, including time-sensitive updates or emergency notifications.

It is important that families enter contact information that they regularly monitor during the summer months, as this information may differ from what is on file during the regular school year. Keeping this information current helps ensure timely communication and supports the safety and well-being of all students participating in summer school programming.

Summer School Transportation:

The Board of Education has approved transportation policy changes for the summer of 2026. These changes are being made to prioritize student safety as well as provide more consistent and predictable transportation for families.

The major policy changes are:

1. The elementary shuttle system will be eliminated for the summer of 2026, with alternative transportation still available. Each elementary school will have direct bus routes for its students to approved alternative locations, including licensed daycare providers designated by the district. Previously, some students were transported between elementary buildings via a shuttle and then transferred to another bus to reach a daycare provider. The updated approach simplifies transportation by reducing transfers and providing more direct routes for students.
2. Alternative bus stop locations will be limited to ensure safe and reliable transportation. Each student may have one consistent morning pick-up location and one consistent afternoon drop-off location, which must remain the same from week to week. For students who reside in two parent or guardian households, both households may be designated as approved pick-up and drop-off locations, provided the schedule for each location is clearly established and remains consistent on a weekly basis.

General Information

Absences: If your child will be absent from summer school classes, please call to let us know. We realize that attendance is not mandatory, but we want to make sure all children are safe and accounted for. The Summer School attendance line is available starting June 15.

Adding/dropping classes: Families will be able to add or drop classes on their own by logging into their Summer School registration account and making the changes themselves. If you wish to replace a class, you need to drop the old class first prior to registering for the new class. Adding classes is subject to availability. **Registration closes May 15, 2026 at midnight. No late registrations will be accepted.** To drop a class after 5/15, please call the Summer School office.

Arrival/Departure: Students should not arrive earlier than 7:35 am at the elementary schools or Intermediate school. Supervision staff is not available prior to that time. Students should be picked up promptly after their last class. Please do not use the bus loop if you are driving your child to school.

- **Arriving late or leaving early?** Please use the main entrance to the building and stop in the school office. The office staff will be happy to help you locate your child.

Catalogs: Dates, times and resident fees as noted. Classes meet Monday-Thursday (exception: Strength and Conditioning).

Class Cancellation: If a course is canceled, parents/guardians will be notified and will be refunded their money.

Classroom Code of Conduct: The Waunakee Community School District is committed to maintaining an educational atmosphere of excellence. Teachers are expected to create a positive classroom environment that is conducive to learning and self-discipline. Students are expected to behave in a manner that is based on respect and consideration for the rights of others.

Class Locations: Classrooms are subject to change. Building and room numbers are noted and on your student's schedule found online through your summer registration account.

Eligibility: All children living within the boundaries of the Waunakee Community School District are eligible to register. The Waunakee Summer School Program is not available for non-residents.

Emergency Closings: In case of an emergency closing, an announcement will be made on local radio and TV stations and on the Waunakee School District website: www.waunakee.k12.wi.

Fees: The Waunakee Community School District summer school fee structure aligns with state requirements. Fees are as noted in the catalog and online. The District does waive fees for those families who are eligible for the federal free or reduced price lunch program and have elected to share that information. Families who have submitted the proper paperwork will have their summer school fees waived after the registration process. The District encourages families with financial need to complete the paperwork and seek the fee waiver if applicable. Contact Business Services for more information at 849-2000 ext.8272.

Health Information: All students—both returning and new to the district—who will need any medication during Summer School must have an individual medication form completed for each medication. This requirement applies to over-the-counter, prescription, and emergency medications, including but not limited to EpiPen, Midazolam, and Glucagon. Required forms are available on the Summer School webpage under the Health Information tab.

Holiday: There will be **no holiday closures** during Summer School 2026.

Locations: Summer School classes will be held at Arboretum Elementary, Heritage Elementary, Prairie Elementary, Intermediate School, the new Middle School, and the High School. **If your child does not or will not attend one of our elementary schools, they must register for elementary classes at the school closest to your child’s home address.**

Materials: The school does not supply notebooks or pencils. The teacher will notify you if your child needs supplies for the class.

Music Camps: Music camps are scheduled after the end of the summer school day. Transportation is not available for music camps.

Music Lessons: Students are **pulled from their regular schedule** for all music lessons. Students should not register for a music lesson during a remedial class. If your child will be bussed, register for a full morning of classes **plus** the music lessons.

Ex: Grades 5-6 register for 3 classes **plus** music lessons for a total of at least 4 classes. Grades 7-12 register for 2 classes **plus** music lessons for a total of at least 3 classes.

Non-Residents/Open-Enrolled/Private School Students: Classes are open to all children living within the boundaries of the Waunakee Community School District and/or currently attending WCSD. The Waunakee Summer School Program is not available for non-residents. Open-enrolled students are eligible to attend summer school. You are considered a non-resident if you have **not** completed your first year of full-time attendance within the Waunakee School District. **If your child does not or will not attend one of our elementary schools, please register for elementary classes at the school closest to your child’s home address.**

Payment: No payments will be collected at time of registration. If a student is registering for Camp Invention which has a fee, payment will be made outside of the registration program. Directions on how to pay the Camp Invention fee will be emailed to the families of students registered for the course. Payment must be made between May 1 - May 15, 2026 in order for your camp registration to be finalized. Failure to pay by that date will result in your camp registration being dropped.

Preschool Classes: The Waunakee Summer School Program is for school age children (students who will be in grades 4K – 12 in the fall). The Aquatics Center and Community Ed Programs offer summer classes for preschool learners. For more information on those classes, please visit the Aquatics Center and Community Ed websites.

Registration: All summer school registration is online or by calling the summer school administrative assistant 608-209-9941. Registration is based on your child's **2026-27** grade.

Refund Policy: Refunds will not be provided for any summer school registrations. The Waunakee Community School District makes decisions on staffing levels and course supplies/materials based on your selections during the registration process. As a result, please do not register for any classes that your student may not attend. Thank you for your consideration.

Remedial Classes for students currently in Grades K-7: "Teacher recommendation only" Students who have been identified in need of remediation will receive an email recommending them for a specific class. This recommendation does not automatically enroll your child in the class. **To register your child for the recommended class:**

Step 1: Enroll your child in the recommended class during online registration.

Step 2: If your child will **not** be attending summer school – reply to the recommendation email you received and to let the appropriate school office know your student won't be attending.

Remedial Classes by teacher recommendation only for students currently in Grades 9-12: This program is designed for students who fail one or two classes in the areas of English, Math, Science, Physical Education/Health and/or Social Studies. Students who failed a class and qualify for the summer remedial program will be notified by the individual teacher. A follow-up letter regarding the recommendation will be sent to Parent(s)/Guardian(s). The student will be automatically enrolled unless the family communicates they won't be attending.

There will be an orientation on the first day of summer school. During this time, students will receive the class, teacher and room information as well as expectations for attendance.

If students need transportation provided in order to attend, please contact The High School at (608)849-2100.

Summer school attendance is essential. All work must be completed at school. Once a student's remedial plan is completed to the supervising teacher's satisfaction, credit will be awarded and no further attendance is required. The student's transcript will be updated with a "P" for Pass and credit for the class will be remediated. Please note the Pass does not replace the F grade, but is an addition to their transcript.

Snacks: Students are welcome to bring a healthy snack to enjoy during the second class period (such as fruit, a granola bar, or a juice box). Please avoid sending candy or sugary snacks like chocolate or soda. To help keep all students safe, we kindly ask families to avoid sending snacks that contain nuts due to food allergies. Students are responsible for their own snacks. Please send a filled water bottle for your child each day.

Special Education Students/English Language Learners: Parents/guardians should work collaboratively with their child's case manager to enroll their child in summer school classes.

Swim Lessons: Contact the Aquatics Director at (608)849-2420 with any questions. All summer swim registrations must go through either online or walk-in registration.

- It is very important to review the level descriptions prior to registration to ensure proper placement. Proper placement is critical for the safety of swimmers and staff. Due to limited seats, it is unlikely there will be space to move swimmers who are not placed correctly. Incorrectly placed swimmers will be dropped or moved to a different time period or session. Swimmers are not allowed to participate in a level that does not match their ability.
- This swim program is progressive and swimmers must pass each level before moving to the next.
- Most swimmers require at least 2 sessions at a level to successfully complete the skills before advancing to the next level.
- If your child cannot perform the required skills on the first day of class, staff will attempt to find an open class at the appropriate level. In many cases, this means changing swim times or sessions.

- For enrollment changes after online registration closes, please contact the Aquatics Center office at 608-849-2420. Staff will be able to assist you Monday - Thursday from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Please do not wait until the first day of classes as space may not be available.
- If you need to make any changes for a future session of swimming lessons, please do so immediately while you are on site and have your progress report. **Changes on the first day of a new session can only be accommodated in rare circumstances as class sizes determine staffing.**

Transportation:

The Waunakee Community School District works in partnership with Lamers Bus Company to provide transportation to and from summer school for our families. For the summer of 2026, all K-12 students registered for summer school that live within the transportation boundaries are automatically enrolled for transportation to and from their home address. Service will be available on the first day of summer school, Monday, June 22, 2026 and continue until July 30, 2026. There is no cost for this service for our families.

Transportation Opt-Out

We are asking for your partnership regarding transportation this summer. You can help alleviate the pressure on our bus system and allow us to not allocate resources for scheduling routes for families not choosing to use this service. You can assist us by opting-out of transportation for summer school programming. If you would like to opt-out of regular transportation for summer school, please complete the online form or on April 7th, 2026 this form is available in your [Infinite Campus School Store](#). Simply fill out the form, add it to your cart, and complete the checkout process. Once submitted, no further action is needed. Opt out forms filled out for the school year do not apply to summer school.

Alternate Transportation Requests

Alternate Transportation is transportation to or from any approved location other than your home address. Alternate transportation requests for Summer School must be submitted between April 7, 2026 and May 22, 2026.

Transportation Exclusions

There is no busing provided during the middle of the Summer School day. There is no summer school transportation for swimming lessons, strength and conditioning, August Training Camp, ACT Prep course, Camp Invention, or any of the music camps.

After the registration deadline, **no additional requests, extensions, or changes** will be accepted for summer school transportation. All alternate transportation requests must be completed through the [Infinite Campus School Store](#). Requests submitted for the **regular school year do not carry over** and **do not apply** to summer school.

Deadlines

There will be no exceptions this year with late deadlines or not registering for alternate transportation. This is transportation to a location other than home address.

Your transportation routes/times for Session 1 will be available in Infinite Campus and My Ride K-12 App on June 15th, 2026. Session 2 routes will be available in Infinite Campus/My Ride K-12 App the afternoon of July 3, 2026.

Wait Lists: Classes fill on a first-come, first-serve basis. There are no wait lists available except for Camp Invention. If you were unable to register a student for Camp Invention because it was full and would like to add your student to the wait list, visit the Summer School webpage. There is a tab for Camp Invention Wait List. Click on the tab and complete the form. The Summer School office will contact you if space becomes available.

Walk-Thru Day: Want to help your child get familiar with the summer school buildings and find his/her classrooms prior to the start of summer school? We invite you and your child to take a self-guided tour through the schools. Maps will be available and classrooms will be labeled. Summer school staff will not be present. The Walk-Thru Day is scheduled for **Wednesday JUNE 17, 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.**

Camp Invention Presents

SPARK

Students who will be entering grades 1-6 may enroll in Camp Invention as a part of summer school. This will save each participant \$210! The cost is \$75 instead of \$285. This program is only open to eligible Waunakee residents and will not appear on a public Camp Invention website.

Registration: Registration for this camp is now included in Summer School registration.

Camp Invention registration opens Tuesday, April 21 at 6:00 PM.

Materials Fee: The fee for Camp Invention will not be paid at time of registration. Registered participants will be sent an email link on May 1, 2026 to pay the \$75.00 along with an online registration form from Camp Invention. This fee along with the registration form will be due by May 15th at noon to keep the registered spot.

Dates: June 15 – June 19, 2026 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Location: DISCOVER is hosted at Arboretum Elementary – 1350 Arboretum Drive in Waunakee.

Transportation: Parents need to provide transportation for Camp Invention

Meals: Participants bring a sack lunch and snack daily.

What is Camp Invention – SPARK

Participants rotate with same aged peers between five classes in this full day Camp Invention experience. Children are empowered to have big ideas while they take on challenges that inspire them to question, brainstorm, collaborate with teammates, and build amazing invention prototypes.

Discover our new 2026 Camp Invention program, SPARK

This year's all-new program is designed to build essential STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) skills while also boosting reading abilities. This is all accomplished through hands-on activities that offer so much fun and excitement, kids don't even realize how much they're learning!



Make Waves

Campers explore waves, buoyancy and surface tension through hands-on water experiments and learn the process of how to create and commercialize inventions. Campers analyze advertisements as inspiration for developing their own billboard boats that glide through the water and help them “make waves” in the market.

Space Morphers

Campers launch a mission to transform a new planet for human habitation using cutting-edge space innovations like rockets, telescopes and satellites. Campers build a DIY Space Rocket to experiment with launch angles and trajectory, work to keep a satellite in orbit and stretch their imagination while extending the frontier.

Infringers

Campers brainstorm, design and miniaturize a top-secret invention while discovering how technology has enabled inventions to become smaller over time. Campers create wearable devices using cryptography, and race to file a patent to protect their inventions from invention-stealing Infringers.

Fur-ensics

Investigating a series of critter crimes, campers sharpen their detective skills as they collect evidence and discover how investigators use forensic science to solve crimes. Campers explore inner mechanics of their robotic capybara sidekick and use creative problem solving to design sleuthing gadgets to support their investigation.
