Standing Authorizations

WHEREAS, the Aurora City Schools Board of Education places responsibility for the financial management of the district on the treasurer and superintendent and,

WHEREAS, the Board is ever mindful of its obligation to the citizens and taxpayers of the City of Aurora to exercise sound fiscal practices, and,

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that sound fiscal practices include the ideal of efficiency and the continuous effort to maximize the value of all resources for the education of all pupils and,

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that in order to meet its obligation to the community, achieve efficiency and maximize the return on its resources, the treasurer and superintendent

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must be able to make certain decisions in a timely and forthright manner within the constraints of applicable statutes and Board policy, and,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Aurora Board of Education hereby approves the following standing authorizations for the calendar year 2026 to be exercised by the treasurer and superintendent only when, in their judgment, such exercise meets the specifications so cited, herein:

- to secure advances from the Auditor when funds are available and payable to the Aurora City School District;
- to invest interim funds at the most productive interest rate whenever such funds are available;
- to pay all bills within the limits of the appropriations resolution as bills are received and when the goods and/or services have been received as ordered;
- to employ and set the salary of such temporary personnel as may be required for emergency conditions, with such employment to be submitted to the Board for action at its next regular meeting.
- to accept resignations which have been submitted by employees during times when the Board is not in session subject to ratification by the Board , however that upon ratification by the Board, such resignations shall be deemed effective as of the date and time of the Superintendent's acceptance.
- to provide to members of the professional and support staff as perquisites plaques and other similar memorials to recognize exemplary and extended service to the school district and appropriate refreshments for curriculum, professional development, orientation, in-service and other similar meetings that are held outside of the normal school day or outside of the normal workplace.
- to apply for funding for the following grants under the guidelines of each grant application and authorize the district's participation in the programs: IDEA-B Flow-Thru, Pre-School, Title VI, Title I, Title II-A, Title III, Title IV-A and any other State or Federally-Funded Grant.
- to authorize releases for the purpose of interscholastic athletic eligibility.
- to authorize a meal or refreshments for staff attending professional meetings on non-teaching days or before/after regular work day hours where determined that expenditures on such amenities are necessary to further public purpose.
- to authorize the payment of reasonable taxes for approved purchases or expenses when a tax exemption certificate cannot be used or its use is impractical under the circumstances.
- to authorize the Superintendent to serve as the trustee on behalf of the Aurora Board of Education in the Portage County Consortium (Health Care Benefits Program and Property and Casualty Insurance Program). The alternate representative, in the event of the absence of the Superintendent, shall be the Treasurer.
- to authorize the Superintendent to admit students in accordance with ORC 3313.64(F)(11), Parent-Grandparent residency clause.
- to resolve special education placement disputes and/or place students out-of-district consistent with the best interests of the School District and the concerns of the affected student;
- to authorize the Superintendent and/or the Superintendent's Designee to assign event admission prices to school events not covered by league assigned admission prices.
